Oakland Tries To Win Over Section 8 Landlords: Oakland, CA Housing Authority officials have begun a campaign to win back landlords who quit the Section 8 project-based voucher program. During the three-year period between 2013 and 2016, Oakland lost more than 1,000 landlords in a city that is one of the Section 8 mainstays. The OHA is trying to lure back landlords with incentives such as a \$500 signing bonus for first-time Section 8 landlords, up to \$2,500 interest-free loans for unit upkeep, and up to two months paid rent between Section 8 vacancies.
