# MAKE Fire Caclet and Police Aide



#### WHAT IS A FIRE CADET AND/OR POLICE AIDE?

The Milwaukee Fire Cadets and Police Aides are civilian employees who serve in a paid apprenticeship-style program to prepare them for careers as Milwaukee Firefighters and Police Officers.

#### WHAT ARE THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS?

- High School graduation (from an accredited high school or home school program) or completion of a HSED or GED prior to July 1, 2019\*.
- > For Fire Cadet: Must be at least 17 years old at time of application; and may not be more than 19 years old on the starting date. Individuals born after Nov. 28, 2001 -or- before August 12, 1999 are not qualified for this examination.
- > For Police Aide: Must be at least 17 years old at the time of application; and may not be more than 20 years old on the starting date. Individuals born after Nov. 28, 2001 -or- before August 12, 1998 are not qualified for this examination.
- > U.S. citizen or authorized to work in the U.S.

#### **Q** WHAT IS THE PAY RATE?

Fire Cadets and Police Aides can make up to \$23,437. They also receive 12 paid vacation days and 11 paid holidays per year and an excellent benefit package.

#### WHAT IS THE TESTING PROCESS?

There are three exams that you must successfully complete in order to be placed on the eligible list for either position:

- 1. Written Exam
- 2. Interview Process
- 3. Physical Ability Test

Once your application is accepted, you will be provided dates for each test. Practice sessions will also be available before each test.

#### WHEN AND WHERE TO APPLY?

The application for Fire Cadet and Police Aide will be available September 21, 2018 through November 28, 2018. Applications are accepted online only, and can be found at City.Milwaukee.gov/FPC.
