The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. 

This report is written by PO Penny Brown, assigned to the License Investigation Unit.

On Saturday, July 29, 2017, I was assigned to work the Wisconsin Wins Youth Tobacco Initiative, which checks area businesses for age compliant tobacco sales. Assisting in this assignment was Amunique M. McGee B/F 10/6/99. McGee is 17yo and not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 9:25A, McGee entered Mobil located at 5979 S. Howell Ave., and purchased a 2 pack of Grape Swisher Sweets Cigars from the cashier. McGee described the cashier as a A/M wearing glasses and a red Mobil Shirt. I entered the store and immediately identified the cashier based on the description, who was identified as: Rashmil Patel A/M 6/19/94. PATEL admitted to the sale and apologized. Patel contacted the agent: Mohammed A. BHIMANI via the telephone to advise of the situation. I advised BHIMANI I would be mailing a packet for enrollment in the M.A.R.T.S. program to his residence.

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.





At approximately 10:45A, McGee entered Hometown located at 108 W. Howard Ave., and purchased a 2 pack of Grape White Owl Cigars from the cashier. McGee described the cashier as a A/M 50's wearing a green button down shirt. I entered the store and immediately identified the cashier based on the description, who was also the agent: Mohammad RAFAQAT A/M 03/15/65. RAFAQAT admitted to the sale and apologized. I advised RAFAQAT that I would be mailing a packet for enrollment in the M.A.R.T.S. program to his residence.

As of 9/21/2017, the agent did not enroll in the M.A.R.T.S. program, therefore, a citation for the initial violation was mailed.
