If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. 3. On 06/04/2016 a 17 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative, was able to purchase a wood tip Black and Mild cigar. The clerk was identified as Saqib EFFENDI, who admitted the sale. He stated he asked her how old she was and she stated 19 so he didn't ask for ID. The applicant was mailed a MARTS letter.

- 4. On 02/08/17 at 2:09 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3708 W North Avenue for a Shotspotter complaint. - 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



This report is being typed by P.O. Jutiki X district #3 squad 3141 working with P.O. Emmons. On Saturday, June 9, 2018 at 8:07 a.m. P.O. Emmons and I were dispatched to the area of N. 27th Street and W. Lisbon Ave. for a complaint of a subject with a gun. Upon arriving at the location P.O. Emmons and I spoke to the caller Pirakyaa J. BARKI B/M (02-11-56). BARKI stated that he came to the BP gas station located at N. 27th Street and W. Lisbon Ave. to get some gas. BARKI stated as he got out his car a heavy set black female walked up to him and stated "sir, sir". BARKI stated that he told the heavy set female "I don't got no money." BARKI stated that he then walked inside the gas station and the female came in the station as he was getting his change back for his gas. BARKI stated the heavy set female entered the

store with a metal object in her hand as she walked towards him. BARKI stated as she walked towards him he put his hands up in the air and the heavy set female snatched his money out his hand.

BARKI went on to describe the suspect as being a heavy set black female wearing reddish shorts and a black hooded sweat shirt. BARKI stated that the suspects were still in the area because they were pushing a blue station wagon. P.O. Emmons and I stopped speaking to BARKI because he stated the suspect were still in the area. As P.O. Emmons and I drove around P.O. Emmons noticed a blue four door station wagon with tinted windows parked in front of the location of 2608 W. Walnut Street facing westbound. P.O. Emmons pulled the squad car behind the vehicle and I noticed a heavy set black female with short hair wearing red shorts and a white t-shirt standing by the driver side door of the car. P.O. Emmons and I got out of the car and walked towards the subject who was later identified as Billie J. LACY B/F (05-07-91). LACY immediately stated that she didn't rob anyone and further stated that BARKI had intentionally given the money to her when they were inside the gas station. P.O. Emmons spoke to LACY further about the incident and I spoke to the subject who was sitting inside the Buick in the drivers seat. The individual identified herself as Shaneika D. ALPHONSE B/F (12-14-90). ALPHONSE stated the following.

ALPHONSE stated that they went to the gas station because the car stopped and they needed a jump. ALPHONSE further stated that LACY asked a subject later identified as BARKI if he had jumper cables. ALPHONSE stated BARKI stated "I'm not giving y'all shit", "not no cables and not no money." ALPHONSE stated she told BARKI that she had a six month old baby and BARKI stated "fuck yo baby." ALPHONSE stated once BARKI stated fuck yo baby LACY got mad and started saying "you said fuck my baby" over and over. ALPHONSE stated that LACY then walked inside the gas station and BARKI gave LACY a lottery ticket. ALPHONSE stated that BARKI left the gas station after LACY received the lottery ticket. ALPHONSE stated that the attendant in the store came out and asked them to leave the area and ALPHONSE stated that they tried to get as far away from the gas station as they could. ALPHONSE first stated she was outside when the incident happened then she stated that she was in the store when the incident happened. I asked ALPHONSE who Buick it was that they were in and ALPHONSE stated that it was hers. I asked her why she didn't have any license plates on her car and ALPHONSE stated that she did have a temporary license plate on the car but it got damage. I asked ALPHONSE where the lottery ticket was and ALPHONSE stated that she didn't know. I finished speaking to ALPHONSE and I noticed that BARKI had driven to the 2600 block of W. Walnut Street and was parked down the street watching P.O. Emmons and I as we investigated this complaint.

P.O. EMMONS called for another squad to respond to the location and squad 3169 (P.O. Lopez and P.O. Michalak) arrived on the scene and assisted in this investigation. After P.O. Lopez and Michalak arrived on scene I walked down the street to further speak to BARKI about this incident. BARKI stated the following.

BARKI stated that he and his wife went to the BP gas station located at 2624 W. Lisbon Ave. to get some gas. BARKI stated once he arrived at the gas station they parked by the gas pumps. BARKI stated that they parked at pump number 2 and the female who stole his money was parked at the gas pump behind him. BARKI stated that he got out his car and walked in the gas station and gave the clerk a \$100 bill for some gas because he and his wife were driving to Chicago this morning. BARKI stated that he paid for his

BARKI stated once he finished filling up his car he walked in the gas station to get his change and a heavy set female later identified as LACY came in the gas station yelling "I'm going to kill you," "I'm going to kill you," as she walked toward him with a pair of what he thought was metal cutters. BARKI stated that he then put his hands in the air and LACY walked up to him and snatched his money out of his hand and walked out the gas station. BARKI stated that he feared for his safety and that's why he put his hands in the air when LACY walked back in the gas station. BARKI stated that he called the Police after LACY took his money and then walked outside and left the gas station with his wife. BARKI stated that the two females we were talking to at 2608 W. Walnut Street were the individuals involved in his incident. BARKI stated that LACY was the one who took his money and was armed with the metal object as she walked toward him in the gas station.

BARKI stated that his change from the gas station was four ten dollar bills and one five dollar bill along with some loose change. BARKI stated that LACY snatched all of it out of his left hand as he held his hands up in the air. I finished speaking to BARKI and I spoke to his wife who was later identified as Maureen OKUNBOR-BARKI B/F (08-21-59). OKNUBOR-BARKI stated the following.

OKNUBOR-BARKI stated that they pulled up to the gas station to get some gas because they were going to Chicago this morning. OKUNBOR-BARKI stated when they got to the gas pump she got out the car to get something out the trunk and BARKI walked into the gas station. OKNUBOR-BARKI stated as she was at the trunk of the car a black female holding a baby wearing red shorts and a hooded sweat shirt walked up to her. OKUNBOR-BARKI stated that the female asked her if she had jumper cables. OKUNBOR-BARKI stated that she told the female that she didn't have any and the female looked at her crazy so she got back in her car. OKUNBOR-BARKI stated that she just sat in the car and waited for BARKI to come out the gas station.

OKUNBOR-BARKI stated as she sat in the car she observed the same heavy set black female walk out the gas station with something in her hand that she thought was possibly a gun yelling "I'm going to bust his head." OKUNBOR-BARKI stated that she feared for her safety and put her hands over her face and sort of leaned to the side in the car. OKUNBOR-BARKI stated that the female just started walking around the gas station. OKUNBOR-BARKI stated that she didn't know what was going on so she call 911 to report the incident because she thought the subject later identified as LACY was going to shoot her. OKUNBOR-BARKI stated that BARKI came back to the car and stated that LACY had snatched his money and he just got robbed.

I finished speaking to OKUNBOR-BARKI and I spoke to P.O. Emmons about what I had found out about this incident. P.O. Emmons told me that P.O. Lopez would be talking to LACY further about this incident. I informed P.O. Emmons that I would be going to the location of 2624 W. Lisbon Ave. to attempt to obtain any video footage regarding this incident. Prior to me arriving at the BP gas station I was informed by P.O Michalak that he had already went to the gas station and discovered that the clerk who was there when this incident happened had already left for the day. P.O. Michalak told me that there was video available regarding this incident at the gas station.

Upon arriving at the gas station I spoke to the clerk (Riaz A. BUTT A/M 04-12-52). BUTT told me that he just got to work a little after 8:00 a.m and the other worker had left already. I asked BUTT if I could watch the video footage of this incident and BUTT stated that I could. I watched the survailence footage

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of the incident. I looked at camera #5, which covered an inside portion of the gas station and pointed north toward the north entrance. As I watched the footage I noticed at 7:55 a.m. ALPHONSE was already in the store standing in line. At 7:56 a.m. I noticed BARKI come into camera view and is also standing in the line in the gas station. ALPHONSE walks up to the counter and then speaks to the clerk and walks out the store. BARKI then walks up to the counter and hands the clerk some money and then leaves the store.

At 7:59 a.m. BARKI comes back inside the store and walks up to the counter and speaks to the clerk again. BARKI then exits the store at 8:00 a.m. At 8:00 a.m. BARKI comes back in the store and walks to the counter and the clerk gives him some money. BARKI is standing there talking to the clerk and gives the clerk back some money and the clerk gives what appears to be a lottery ticket to BARKI.

BARKI is standing there holding the money and the lottery ticket in his left hand when LACY walks into the gas station towards BARKI in an aggressive manor. As LACY walked toward BARKI I observed him put his hands in the air as he stood next to the counter. LACY continued to walk towards BARKI and walked up to him and snatched the money out of his left hand and turned to leave out the gas station. As LACY turned to leave out the gas station I observed an object with yellow grips and a black top in her right hand as she walked towards the exit.

As LACY exited out the store the clerk gave BARKI a phone and he called someone. BARKI just stood in the store after this incident happened and ALPHONSE walked in. ALPHONSE started talking to BARKI and then to the clerk in the store and finally walked out the gas station also. BARKI walked out the gas station and out of camera view inside the store. I finished watching the footage from the inside of the gas station and informed P.O. Emmons what I had observed.

P.O. Emmons instructed me to come back to the location of 2608 W. Walnut Street to take some photos of the scene because P.O. Lopez had recovered some items from the Buick station wagon. I walked back over to the location of 2608 W. Walnut Street and I was informed by P.O. Emmons that a cutting tool, a lottery ticket and some money was recovered from the auto. P.O. Emmons had gotten consent and read Milwaukee Police Department form PF-3 to ALPHONSE to be allowed to search her car. ALPHONSE signed the form and her 1995 Buick station wagon was searched.

I took several photos of the cutting tool, forty-five dollars in United States currency and one Wisconsin lottery ticket. I also took a photo of the vehicle Lacy and ALPHONSE was in as well as the gas station where the incident happened. The forty five dollars and lottery ticket where given back to BARKI and I asked him about the lottery ticket. BARKI stated that he forgot he bought it when he went in the store. I took a picture of BARKI with all his items. (four ten dollar bills and one five dollar bill, Wisconsin lottery ticket). BARKI took his items and left the area.

District #3 dispatcher was contacted and a Forensic Investigator was called to the scene to obtain video from the BP gas station. Squad 1724 (Forensic Investigator J. Hinkel) arrived on the scene and recovered the video from the gas station. After the video was recovered LACY was conveyed to Central Booking for processing. As she was being conveyed to Central Booking she kept on saying that BARKI had intentionally given her the money and she didn't steal it from him.

The metal cutting tool she had in the car was placed on inventory#1802133 along with the hooded sweat shirt she had on at the time of the offense. The surveillance footage was also placed on that same inventory. I watched additional footage of the gas station at district #1 and noticed that on camera #4, which covered the south side gas pump area and south entrance. At 7:41 a.m. the Buick LACY was in with ALPHONSE was pushed into the parking lot by a small four door auto. The vehicle pushed the Buick to pump #4. I continued to watch the footage as LACY and ALPHONSE walked around the gas station parking lot on the south side of the gas station. At 7:55 a.m. BARKI pulls into the gas station and parks at gas pump #2. BARKI gets out the car and walks to the back passenger seat on the driver side and opens up the back door. BARKI then closes the door and walks in the gas station. BARKI comes back out the gas station and pumps his gas and walks back into the gas station. BARKI leaves the gas station and walks back to his car and then goes back in the gas station again. At 8:01 a.m. I observe LACY walk over to BARKI car as he was in the gas station and began waving her arms in the air near BARKI'S car like she was upset. ALPHONSE walks over to LACY by BARKI'S vehicle and LACY continues to make hand gestures with her hands. At 8:02 a.m on camera #4 LACY turns toward the gas station and walked toward the south door. As LACY was walking I could see that she had some type of object in her right hand as she walked toward the entrance. ALPHONSE stayed outside and didn't go inside the gas station. ALPHONSE walked towards the door and LACY exited the gas station as ALPHONSE got next to the door. It appeared that LACY had something in her hand as she came out the gas station.

After LACY exited the gas station ALPHONSE walked inside the gas station and BARKI exited out and walked to his car. BARKI got in his car and drove away eastbound on W. Lisbon Ave. out of camera view. ALPHONSE exited out the gas station and she and LACY stayed at the gas station until 8:08 a.m., which time a four door red SUV came and gave the car a push out the parking lot and out of camera view. I could see LACY wasn't in the car when it was pushed off the gas station lot. LACY follow behind on foot and walked out of camera view. This case is ordered into the District Attorney's office for Monday, June 11, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. Further follow up will be conducted to located the gas station clerk.

Regarding this investigation the case was charge by the District Attorney's office. I notified the owner of the business (Aftab, Sultan A/M 09-18-66) and told him about the robbery complaint on June 18, 2018 at 8:30 a.m.


