**Description of work** Repair front dormer windows with epoxy and natural wood materials. New putty and new glass (in the same size) are approved if necessary. Re-side front dormers with new clear cedar clapboard to match existing reveal, provide appropriate underlayment, and paint. Repair/replace plaster and wood moldings, trim, and decorative features to replicate existing.

> Option to replace storm windows on dormers with new storm windows that have a wood frame and have sash heights that match the primary window.
