There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.



ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

This location is currently a laundry mate that will be eventually converted into a liquor store. The licensee explained to me what this location will look like once construction and rehab is complete. Licensee intends on installing 3-4 exterior cameras and 10 interior cameras. He intends to have two cameras positioned on the front door with two large monitors inside that display everyone who walks in. The camera system he intends to install will be digital DVR system that store footage for 90 days. Licensee intends to put the employee cash register check our area behind a separate glass partition. This licensee currently holds a liquor license with the City of Milwaukee and had multiple liquor stores in the City. I would recommend doing a second survey with the Police Department of this establishment once construction is in process or almost complete before opening



- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

This report is written by PO Christian SANCHEZ-ALCANTAR, assigned to District 2, late shift, with PO Richard MENZEL, squad 2390.

On July 26th 2018, at approximately 12:20 AM, we responded to a Theft call at 575 W Becher St, located in the city and county of Milwaukee. 575 W Becher St is a filling station named ASR Petroleum.

Upon arrival, I spoke with an employee, Shoaib I KIYANI (A/M 09-02-91), who said at approximately 5:30 PM on July 25th 2018, three teenagers went into the business and started putting approximately 20 miscellaneous bags of assorted lays chips into coolers before confronting another employee working there at the time then leaving with the stolen items. KIYANI said that the three teenagers sell water regularly on the I-43 exit and entrance ramps located on W Becher St. KIYANI said that this isn't the first time that the teenagers have stolen from the business, however this is the first time they stole a large amount of items.

KIYANI had video cameras recording the entire incident. Video surveillance shows three teenagers entering the business with two coolers and stopping by the area where the chips are located. The employee working there at the time steps away from the cash register and confronts the teenagers. One

of the suspects immediately begins to argue with the employee, while the other two suspects begin filling the coolers with miscellaneous bags of assorted lays chips. The employee attempts to take the chips out of the coolers, but suspect 1 confronts the employee while the other two suspects exit the business with the filled coolers. The employee attempts to go outside to get the bags of chips out of the coolers, but suspect 1 presses himself against the door from the outside, so the employee was unable to open the door to get outside. All suspects flee from the business in an unknown direction.

While the names of the suspects are unknown at this time, I was able to get a description of each subject:

Suspect 1 was a B/M, approximately 15-16 years old, Heavy Build, wearing a WHITE T-shirt, RED basketball shorts, and sandals.

Suspect 2 was a B/M, approximately 13-14 years old, Slim Build, wearing a BLU T-shirt, GRAY shorts, and sandals.

Suspect 3 was a B/M, approximately 11-12 years old, Slim Build, wearing a durag, WHITE Tank top, GRAY basketball shorts, and sandals.

I gave the employee a Victim Resources sheet for the business. I obtained the information of the business and the business agent in order to write a license premise report. We told the employee that we did not have equipment to download the video surveillance, however we would speak with a CLO on Day Shift to go there to retrieve the recordings.


