

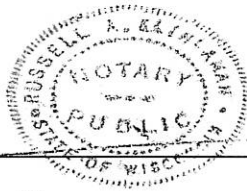

City Share Assessable Paving Fund - \$0

City Share Non-Assessable Paving Fund - \$148,700
