Your Food Dealer Restaurant License Application as agent for "Freddy's Tacos LLC" for "Freddy's Tacos" at 4519-21 W CENTER St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

### Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street, Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

My (

This letter is to express grave objections to the location of this business. It is virtually in my back yard.

Please understand that this area is extremely congested already and over-filled with some people who seem not to care about our neighborhood.

You have asked for an immediate response to this license request so I will only give immediate complaints that I am aware of first hand. There are many others that I am sure could be documented given time to get dates and more facts.

Daily, people throw plastic bags, liquor bottles, food containers, cups, cans, bottles, food rappers, hair pieces, clothing, book bags, dog feces, dirty diapers, on my property and onto our nearby streets.

My garbage cans are often filled with pizza boxes, toys, cardboard boxes and lots of debris from people in the area. Needless to say, sewer rats follow.

Last week I complained bitterly because of a large amount of old furniture, a toilet commode, and other junk in the alley way on the  $\cdot$ 

Broken glass, 10 to 12 pairs of used plastic gloves were removed from a nearby corner lot.

Every few weeks, people throw mattresses, old furnace, paste board boxes, tree branches and large amounts of garbage in our alley ways.

People put sofas in the alley way and congregate; talking loudly and give the area a bad appearance.

People feel free to walk and/or sit on my lawn and my steps and leave evidence of their presence.

People converse loudly as they walk along the sidewalks.

Often women and men have disputes, and loud conversations can be heard.

Very recently there have been AT LEAST THREE major car accidents within a few feet in f One lady was pulled out of the windshield of an overturned vehicle in front of this location. Two serious car wrecks at the intersections on 46<sup>th</sup> and 47<sup>th</sup> Center street intersections occurred recently.

Speeding is common in this area. Cars, motor cycles, bikes, emergency vehicles headed to a nearby hospital (old St. Joe's Hospital) are ALREADY a problem.

AT OUR SHERMAN PARK COMMUNITY MEETINGS (COMMON GROUND and SPAN) neighbors bitterly complain of the noise, congestion and frequent police calls because of a similar licensed establishment in our area.

Police or business owners obviously cannot monitor the behavior of large numbers of unruly citizens.

Our area is already a problem without adding another business that will bring additional immature, uncaring people into the area.

After a recent house break-in I have now added the expense of burglary surveillance; other neighbors have followed suit.

As long time, responsible citizens we have worked two or three jobs to acquire our property and live peaceably in the city. It is extremely depressing to have people come into our neighborhood and

Make our daily lives miserable.

MY NEIGHBORS AND I ARE WORKING TO IMPROVE THE SHERMAN PARK AREA. WE WANT A PLACE WHERE WE CAN INVITE OUR FRIENDS AND ENJOY A PEACEFUL ENVIRONMENT.

Please check police data and you can verify that we have enough problems already. This type of business in this location will NOT improve the Sherman Park area or Milwaukee.

PLEASE HELP US IMPROVE OUR NEIGHBORHOOD, NOT TURN IT INTO A DESPERATE GHETTO.

If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

The following issues were discussed:

- Trainings being implemented for employees regarding how and when to contact the police.
- Providing the police department with contact information for each store location manager and Standard Operating Procedure plans.
- The sign and cement slab at the 930 N 27<sup>th</sup> St location that is being used as a seating area.
- A plan to address parking lot litter and garbage collection

This report was written by PO James BORNEMAN, assigned to District 3, Early Shift.

On Thursday, February 1, 2018, at approximately 4:35 PM, PO Karlee KENNON and I, Squad 3240, were dispatched to a Property Damage at 2510 W North Av, in the City and County of Milwaukee, which was the Family Dollar Business.

Upon arrival I spoke with the caller, Danyelle G CROWLEY (b/f, 8-25-1987), who was the assistant manager at the Family Dollar. She stated at approximately 4:25 PM, she observed a suspicious B/M subject (suspect #1) in the store. CROWLEY stated the suspect was pacing back and forth, and looking around as if he was going to make a "run" for it. She stated he was holding four sets of head phones. CROWLEY stated she advised security about the suspect and to go by the exit door. She stated once the suspect left, the suspect returned a few minutes later and threw an unknown object at a glass window of the business, breaking it.

CROWLEY stated she then contacted her store manager, Patrick MCGRAW (b/m) and informed him of the incident. CROWLEY stated MCGRAW advised her that he would be coming to the store to view the video surveillance. MCGRAW arrived on scene and allowed us access to the video surveillance. MCGRAW also adivsed the general manager of the incident. He also did not request a board-up. I issued MCGRAW a PV-17 Crime Victim Resource.

Upon viewing the video, I observed the B/M suspect wearing a black coat, red hoody, black and gray winter hat that appeared to have a "G" on it, possibly the Green Bay Packers logo. At approximately 4:30 PM, I observed the suspect run out of the exit door, return later and threw an unknown object through a window breaking it.

MCGRAW later gave a copy of the video to us, which was inventoried as evidence under MPD INV#18004569.



This report was written by PO Corianna CAVAZOS, assigned to District 3, Modified Early Shift. On 2/19/2018, Squad 3245, PO Phillip GAGNON and I, responded to 2400 W North Ave for a 'Subject with Weapon' call. Upon arrival, I spoke with the caller, Tracy PERRY (BM, 05/21/74) who stated that he was involved in an altercation with the manager of the Family Dollar located at 2510 W North Ave. PERRY stated that, after having a verbal altercation inside of the store, the store manager, who was later identified as Patrick R. MCGRAW (BM, 10/15/1982), followed him to the bus stop located at 2400 W North Ave and struck him in the face using a closed fist and causing PERRY to suffer pain and swelling to his left cheek. MCGRAW stated that he has a valid CCW license and carries his firearm when he is outside of the store but was not carrying his firearm inside of the store while he was working. PERRY was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct and both MCGRAW and PERRY were ordered into the District Attorney's office regarding the Battery while Armed (IR 180500066). - 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

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I presented O'DEY a list of the incident reports filed for the last year (10/10/2017 - 10/10/2018) for each of the District three family dollar locations as well as the amount of calls for service at each of the Family dollar locations.

O'DEY stated that she was aware of the district three locations as being particularly challenging store locations. She stated that Family Dollar leadership was making strides to improve the locations. She stated that high employee turn-over was part of the difficulty in maintaining well-run store locations.

After discussing the issues, the group highlighted the following areas of concern:

- The need for trainings being implemented for employees regarding how and when to contact the police.
- Providing the police department with contact information for each store location manager and Standard Operating Procedure plans.
- The sign and cement slab at the 930 N 27th St location that is being used as a seating area.
- A plan to address parking lot litter and garbage collection
- Efforts to address loitering and panhandling outside of the stores and in parking lot.
- The current security guard employment (28 hours unarmed/ weekly) and whether or not this is sufficient.
- The Organized Retail Crime management position (whether or not you will be proceeding with this plan)
- Whether or not the new management team has been successful in enforcing the store standards and policies (such as parking lot and store cleanliness, monitoring cash counts and proper unloading of semi deliveries)
- Scheduling site visits and Crime Prevention through Environmental Design surveys at each location.

These items were brought to O'DEY as areas of concern that would require follow up. O'DEY stated she would work on addressing these items and committed to a follow up meeting to be set for the last week of October 2018 with an update on these items. She also stated she would bring the store managers to the next meeting so that they were all aware and on the same page about the plan of action.


