There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

I just received a *Notice of Public Interest* via snail mail about the Fermented Malt Beverage license application by applicant Sunshine J. Johnson, Agent Mitchell Oasis, LLC, address 6203 W. Capitol Drive, Milwaukee, 53216.

This email is to inform you that I, along with my neighbors, are organizing against this application! I will be sending off my objections in a letter as well as an email, directed to the City Clerk License Division.

You can expect further letters, emails, and action opposing the malt license from the in the days ahead.

The idea of selling malted beverages (beer) on a residential block and school bus corner is a terrible and dangerous idea. The corner of 62nd and Capitol is already very congested with many traffic concerns because of Wendy's, Capitol Oasis, and Boost being in such close proximity. The addition of beer for sale does not bode

well for our neighborhood, already plagued by crime, litter, and traffic problems. Beer can be purchased in the neighborhood at Pick n' Save two blocks away, or at Otto's, on Appleton Avenue.

Please let me know if there is a meeting date for this licence application. I will definitely clear my calendar so that I and my neighbors can attend.

Chevy, I hope you will support us in our efforts to keep beer in liquor stores and supermarkets instead of in a corner snack shop, just steps away from our homes.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 4/3/2019 at 9:15 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.



ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

Windows out to the street side parking/capitol Dr were partially blocked by signage and food stands, recommended trying to reduce the clutter. Rear door that leads to the employee parking lot had boxes and other material stacked near it and was recommended to remove the items for fire safety and tripping hazard.

Business is alarmed through ADT for both burglary and robbery protections. Register is located behind glass enclosure with small opening for transactions and the door is locked at all times and can't be reached by reaching through the register windows. Store does not appear to sell items used in narcotics consumption outside of several glass smoking pipes located behind the counter.

BUSINESS LICENSE PLAN OF OPERATION



On Monday, July 2nd, 2018, Squad 7420 (P.O. Charles SCAIFE and myself) was dispatched at approximately 12:07 AM to the Wendy's restaurant at the address of 6225 W Capitol Dr, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin to investigate a property damage complaint.

Upon arrival I spoke with the District Manager of Wendy's, Rolando MALDONADO (h/m, 1-14-1979), regarding this incident. MALDONADO stated an employee, Joshua C ARMSTRONG (b/m, 12-28-1993), intentionally and without consent damaged the drive-thru window beyond the point of repair.

MALDONADO allowed us to review surveillance footage which captured the incident. A copy of the surveillance footage was sent to the D.A.'s office.

SUMMARY OF THE SURVEILLANCE VIDEO:

The video shows ARMSTRONG in verbal altercation with another Wendy's employee. It is unknown what the argument was about or how it started. ARMSTRONG removes his t-shirt, grabs his backpack and exits through the backdoor.

ARMSTRONG approaches the drive-thru window from the outside and strikes the window with his right fist. ARMSTRONG strikes the window with enough force that it shatters the glass and damages it beyond repair. ARMSTRONG flees the area in an unknown direction.

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

GARCIA stated if he is granted a license he will open, Mama Lou's Bar, around the middle of April. Along with the tavern are three apartments located on the second floor above the tavern. GARCIA stated he plans on renting out all three apartments.

During a walkthrough of the property I observed no interior or exterior security cameras. GARCIA stated he plans on adding one to two cameras on both the interior and exterior of the property. He also stated he plans on adding additional exterior lighting and fortifying all exterior doors and doors adjoining to the apartment spaces.


