Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. ## Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

The applicant was advised of the concern and advised his security to stop allowing patrons inside. A count was done as the patrons left the building. The total count of patrons and staff was 192 people which is 102 over capacity. On 12/19/2018 a meeting was held at District 1 regarding the over capacity on 12/01/2019. The applicant stated there was a special event that night and there was a private security company along with his regular security. The applicant was issued a citation for over capacity.

#### INITIAL INVESTIGATION

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This report is written by PO Molly PLUMLEY assigned to District One, Late Power shift.

On Saturday, December 1, 2018 at approximately 12:40 AM I along with PO Jesse MATTSON was on foot patrol in the 1100 block of N. Old World Third Street (Code Red assignment). While on patrol we walked past Truth Lounge (1111 N. Old World Third St.) and noticed a very large crowd of patrons inside of the tavern. PO MATTSON and I are familiar with this tavern from our weekend patrol and have not observed a crowd of this size before. After observing the crowd through the window I went back and asked the security officer at the door what their count of patrons was. The security officer who was later identified as HILL, Kenneth L. (B/M 8/14/1983) thought that they had about 90 people in the tavern but was not sure of the exact amount. HILL did attempt to add and subtract the amounts of patrons he was letting in and out but could not give an exact amount of people that he let in. It should also be noted that HILL was not aware that staff members were included in the total occupancy of the tavern so he did not count them.

I notified Sgt. Timothy GAUERKE of the situation and that we thought the tavern was over occupancy. Sgt. GAUERKE and Sgt. ACKLEY responded to our location along with PO Jared HINSENKAMP and PO Joseph BOEHLKE. Sgt. GAUERKE and Sgt. ACKLEY informed us that we were going to do a count of the patrons in the tavern. PO HINSENKAMP and PO MATTSON went to the rear door of the location to count individuals that would possibly leave out of the back door. Sgt. GAUERKE, Sgt. ACKLEY, and PO BOEHLKE went into the tavern and notified the agent BATES, Tino K. (B/M 2/14/1972) that they appeared to over their DNS occupancy and that we would be doing a count of the patrons. At that time BATES informed his staff that they would not be letting any new customers into the tavern.

I started counting the patrons that left the tavern at approximately 12:42 AM and did not stop counting until the tavern was closed and all patrons were gone from the establishment. At approximately 2:00 AM I counted 172 patrons that exited the front/main door of the tavern. PO MATTSON counted 3 patrons that left out of rear door of the tavern during the time that we were counting. It should be noted that patrons exited both the rear and front door to smoke but were not counted until they departed for the

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rest of the night. After the count of patrons was completed I went inside with Sgt. GAUERKE and counted 17 staff members that were working. I added the three numbers which was 192 people inside of tavern at the time we started counting. This number is 102 people over their posted DNS occupancy.

Sgt. GAUERKE and I explained to BATES that he was 102 people over his posted occupancy. We then explained to BATES that he would be receiving a citation (#61550031) for Maximum Authorized Occupancy, and a tavern report would be completed regarding this investigation.

I informed BATES that I had to hand write the citation and would be back to serve him with it sometime within the next week.

This report is written by PO Molly PLUMLEY, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift.

On Wednesday, December 19, 2018 at approximately 1:00 PM in the District One conference room a meeting was held with BATES regarding his Maximum Authorized Occupancy citation. I along with PO Jesse MATTSON, SGT. Chad RADEN, LT. Timothy LEITZKE, and Assistant City Attorney Saveon GRENELL explained to BATES that he would be receiving a citation for Maximum Authorized Occupancy, what the deposit amount was, and the future court date he was given. During the meeting Sgt. RADEN asked BATES if there was something special going on the night of the violation that would have caused a larger crowed and more patrons. BATES responded that he was hosting a special event and did not state specifically what the event was. BATES did inform us that there was a private security company working along side his security for this special event.

District One Officers did locate an advertisement for an album release party for an artist named Slow Down KID on the Truth Lounge Instagram page that was dated for Friday, November 30, 2018. This event was taking place at the time of the violation.

It should be noted that the citation listed in the original License Premise report (#61550031) was issued for the wrong court date and was voided. I did issue a new citation (#61620812) for the same violation but with a new court date of January 28, 2019 at 8:30 AM.

## **INITIAL INVESTIGATION**

This report is written by Police Officer Jesse MATTSON, assigned to District #1 on late power shift on squad car 1430 with partner Police Officer Molly PLUMLEY. On Thursday December 6th, 2018 PO PLUMLEY and I were assigned on a CODE RED assignment on Old World Third Street. Our duties include monitoring the taverns and businesses within the area. At approximately 1:55 AM, I observed a tan vehicle pull up in front of Truth Lounge located at 1111 North Old World Third Street. I observed 2 males get out of the vehicle vehicle and enter the tavern. Typically I know taverns have a general practice of having doors locked when close of business hours approach to limit access to the business to customers. After observing the males enter the business PO PLUMLEY and I drove our marked squad car directly in front of the business to observe inside the business. I observed approximately 15 to 20 persons inside the business. PO PLUMLEY and I waited outside the tavern until 2:01 AM. While waiting outside the tavern 6 females who appeared to be customers exited the tavern just prior to 2:00 AM. At 2:01 AM I PO PLUMLEY and I created an official electronic dispatch assignment of a tavern check at 1111 North Old World Third Street.

The tavern door was unlocked allowing us entry to the business. I observed several persons still inside the tavern including persons I have personal knowledge to be either managers, bartenders or employees from previous interactions at the tavern. I observed several patrons inside the business taking photos in front of a Truth Lounge backdrop as I entered.

Eric A. ELIM (M/B 05/04/1973) who stated he was owner of the tavern did approach PO PLUMLEY and me to see how he could assist us. ELIM was asked why so many people were inside the tavern after the hours of operation. ELIM then did acknowledge some of the persons inside the tavern were patrons and were just taking some pictures prior to leaving. PO PLUMLEY and I explained it was a violation for the business to have customers inside after hours of operation. While speaking with ELIM 4 patrons exited the tavern. , my husband and I are the owners of the . We left the Chicagoland area to purchase the mansion to open it as a Bed & lam, Breakfast, 10 years ago. The city has set a law in place that if you are to own a B&B, have more than 2 rooms, then you have to have the B&B in a certain area of Milwaukee. To abide by the law we purchased the mansion with Sundeep Liquor & Foods is 3 block from our location. The mansion was in very poor condition, we are still in the process of making it a beautiful place to stay. With beautiful mansion that a walts the guests, the joy of my guests in the process of driving to our place, get a very different ploture of the area right from the start.

GPS gives them directions to get off the highway and come down 35 St. Street. Then make a right on W. Wells. Right at that point many of my guests are really questioning whether they should even stay. Why?

It starts with Sundeep Liquor & Food is on 3447 W. Wells Street, the corner of 35th and W. Wells. Owned by Kinkun, Inc. - we call "at the moment" store because "at that moment, they have to have a drink or something to eat"

Observations

1. There is a large traiffc flow that comes in and out. Many customers do NOT leave but hang out around the building, either drinking their purchase or hanging out with others.

2. For those to leave, 3 blocks gives them just enough time to drink or eat their purchase and then just drop, throw or toss the container, into my bushes, yard and sidewalk. "Black"

plastic bags are blowing every where. (It has become their trademark)

3. There are also many apartments that are located on W. Wells. In the evening we sit on our porch and we watch many, I mean many people walk out of their apartment heading west, we know where they are going, about 15 minutes later they are carrying that "black"bag filled with items or watch them "toss" the container of what they just are from Sundeep Liquor & Food. Sometimes a couple of times a day the same person heads to the store. Do not forget there are many apartments on W. Wells.

4. Remember my guests are not to sure about even staying when they turn on W. Wells St.. As much as we can we will assure them, every thing is ok. We ourselves are not so sure and walt:......these people have purchased their drink(s) for the evening and then there is trouble. This past summer just in the month of July. I had to call the police 65 times because of things that were happening just in the apartment across the street from us. That is not counting the other apartments I have called on. Both 911 (gun shootings or fights) and Non emergence know me by name. I am always interacting with the police, and every time they say that alcohol is involved. This is NOT good for our business. Not so mention what it is doing for reviews from the internet.

5. Then you have those who sit in their car drinking and playing the radio very load, I mean load, waking up us and the guests. Then, after 1 hour or 2 of drinking, they just drive away.

(by the way this happened at 3:45 am last night)

6. I have interacted with people who live in the apartments, they have shared with me that they like the location of where they live because of Sundeep Liquor & Food, it is walking distance from their home. Easy to get to.

7. We will be out in our yard working and people, both men and woman have just gone up to our mansion and pissed on our mansion, right in front of us. We ask them why? (while they are holding their "black"bag.) Reply - "cause" and walk away.

8. 3 times a day, we have to pick up "fresh" trash that has been tossed. In the morning, it is nothing to fill 2 "black"bags of this trash. It is all "in the moment" items.

This neighborhood is trying to clean the area up. We are working with the apartment management in dealing with the people who live in their buildings. But for as much as they may try, they cannot control the consumption of alcohol they drink.

All of this really needs to start with each person - oneself. But when one does not want to respect themselves or others. Then other actions need to be taken.

That is why we are asking, *pleading* that you would not renew the license of Sundeep Liquor & Food. We find that this business is NOT a plus to this area but FEEDS to the troubles that are already there.

I am not looking forward to this summer, and the scary issues that could occur, similar to all summer long last year. This did not just start last year, this problem has been here since we moved here in 2008. It is just getting worst.



- Drinking outside the premises, neighborhood, and in vehicles, on private property (trespassing)
- Public urination and indecent exposure
- Sitting on steps drinking and passed out on lawns
- · Alcohol garbage littered thru out the neighborhood (Nips, 1/2 plints, single can and bottle of beer)
- Panhandling to buy liquor and break ins
- Minors in possession of alcohol
- Fighting, assaults, verbal or physical harassment of patrons.

- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
