I received a letter from the City of Milwaukee denying a claim for a 1997 Chevy Lumina that was trapped in the rain storm and submerged with water, that ended up totaling the car. On June 19, 2009 at 1 a.m. as I stated in the last letter my car was totaled due to the City not notifying the (ISD) Infrastructure Services Division that there was built-up debris that clogged up their grates.

The letter I received denying my claim states that the City contacted the (ISD) at 1;45 a.m. because of clogged catch basins on West Capitol Drive from 35<sup>th</sup> to North 32<sup>nd</sup>. It clearly states that a sewer jet opened six basins that had debris on their grates at the time my car was submerged in water. It then goes on to say that after the claim was filed the ISD checked all the basins in the area and found them to be properly working after the claim was filed, it didn't say that the basins was properly working on June 19, 2009 at 1a.m. because if the basin was properly working then the ISD shouldn't had to come out at 1;45a.m. 45min. after my car was submerged in water and totaled. In this appeal I'm asking who's at fault? Is it Kambi Washington's fault for trusting the city of Milwaukee to prevent such a thing from happening, or is it the (ISD) fault for coming out 45 minutes later and opening the basin? Who's fault is it? The City is at fault and if the call was made to the ISD early that day knowing the amount of rain Milwaukee was due to get a lot of people would still have personal transportation. Due to this incident I couldn't trade my car in for Cash for Clunkers because my car was totaled due to the basins not being unclogged. I can't file a claim with Fema because the City was at fault and can't put in a claim with Fema because it was their fault, so who's fault is it???


