There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

**Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license: Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 5/14/2019 at 10:15 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

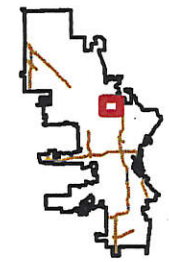
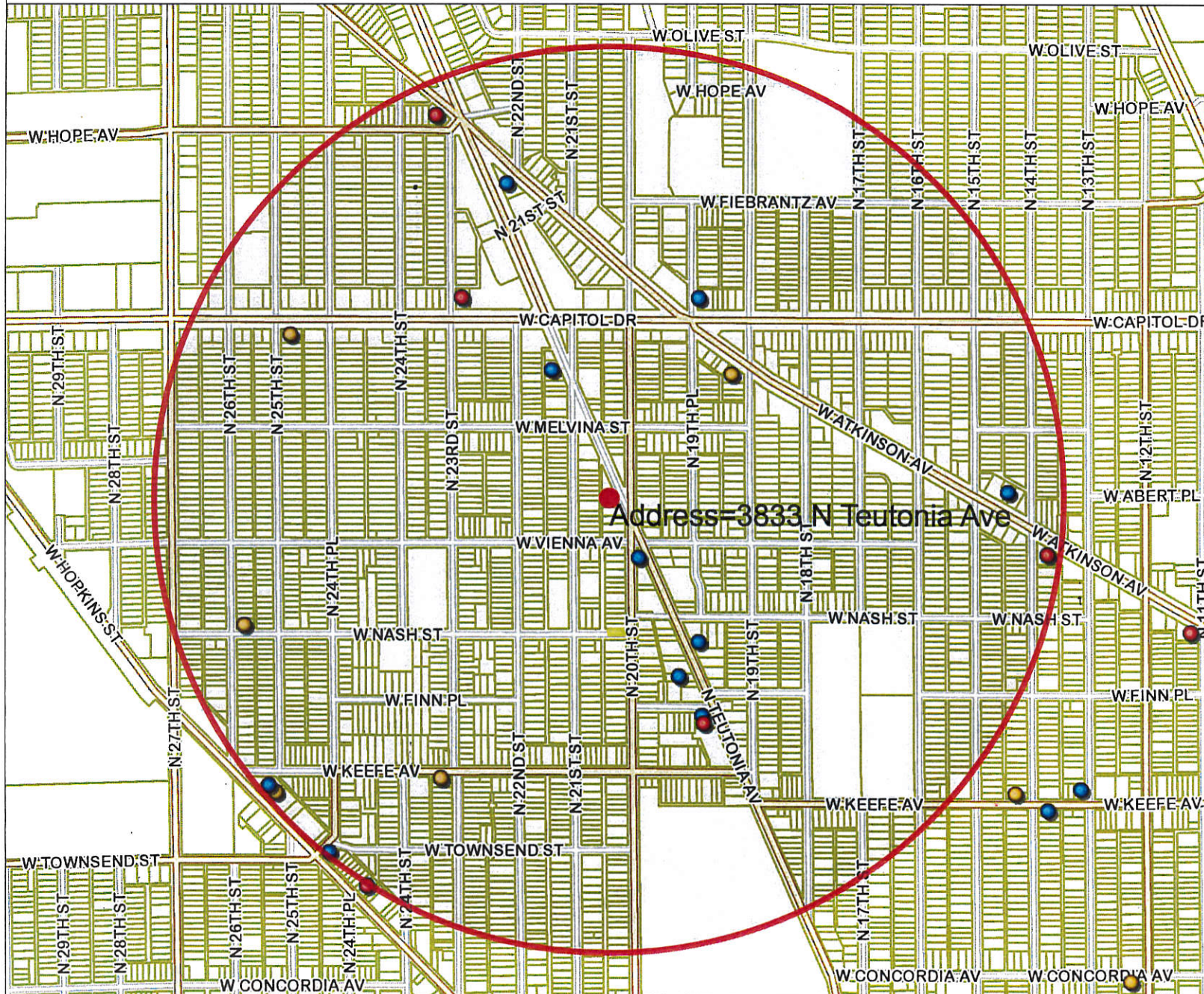
I recommended he install motion lights on the south exterior wall. There is no lighting and a residential home is next door. Update existing exterior lighting.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. **INCIDENT:** On 02/11/95 at about 1:45AM one Corey Pittman was in the process of exiting the Ret Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton when he got into a confrontation with patrons who were entering the tavern. Mr. Pittman was shot at least 6 times, and died on the sidewalk in front of the tavern. At least 23 shots were fired at pittman and a friend.
2. **INCIDENT:** On 08/17/96 at 2:30AM Officers were dispatched to the Ret Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton St. for shots fired. Officers spoke to the bar manager who stated that she had a problem with a customer but he left. She did say that she had heard two shots from outside in front of the tavern but she did not see anything.
3. **INCIDENT:** On 09/01/96 at 2:39AM Officers were dispatched to the Ret Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton St. for a shooting. Officers found two subjects inside the tavern that had been shot. Investigation revealed that the two subjects had been in the Ret Lounge and left at closing, and were shot while standing in front of the tavern. Two of the projectiles had penetrated into the wall of the tavern.
4. **INCIDENT:** On 01/05/97 at 2:20AM Officers were flagged down by a citizen regarding a Battery complaint which occurred at the Ret Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton St. The victim stated that two of her friends got into an argument inside the tavern, and turned on her hitting her in the head with a beer bottle, biting her on the arm, and beat her about her face and body. The suspects were arrested for Battery.

5. On 11/12/98 the applicant was issued a citation for failing to pay for his 1998/1999 food license for 3400 N. Holton St. The case was dismissed.
6. INCIDENT: On 05/14/00 at about 1:59AM Officers were dispatched to investigate a report of shots fired call from 3423 N. Buffum St. Upon the Officers arrival Officers found several bullet casings in front of the Ret's Lounge located at 3400 N. Holton St. Upon interviewing the bartender of the tavern, she stated that after the tavern closed she heard shots fired outside of the tavern. No one observed the person who fired the shots. Officers did recover 34 casings from the area. No one from the tavern called the Police. Criminal Complaint filed.
7. INCIDENT . On 2-3-2001, an anonymous citizen reported that a man was pistol whipped at the Rhett Lounge, 3400 N Holton Street. The caller hinted that the actors were gang members. Investigating officers confirmed that the incident had occurred. Three males with handguns attacked the victim. The bartender stated she threatened to call the police to stop the suspects hitting the victim, but she never called. Once the incident was over the victim related that he did not need an ambulance and asked that the police not be called. The reason was that he was on parole, and feared that having police contacted would violate his parole. The victim was beaten because he made it known that he no longer wanted to be in the gang, and he was confronted by at least six Vice Lord gang members, while at the Rhett Lounge. The suspects were identified, and are all members of the Vice Lord street gang. The incident is currently under review by the District Attorney's office and a disposition is pending.
8. INCIDENT On 2-20-03, at 8:00PM, Milwaukee Police were sent to Rhett Lounge, 3400 N Holton Street, to check for a man wanted for robbery. Upon arrival, police found the suspect sitting at a table. From the suspect's jacket, officers discovered a Glock pistol that was later discovered to be stolen. Also observed seated at the bar was another male who appeared young. Upon checking, he was found to be 19 years old. The licensed bartender, Annie D Reed, was given a verbal warning and the licensee, LC Whitehead was advised.

The following Citations issued to Anthony Whitehead, who is an officer.

9. On 2-16-04, officers on routine patrol in the 2500 block of N 5th Street, observed two subjects exit the side door of the Met Tavern, 541 W Clarke Street, and one subject identified as Anthony Whitehead standing in the doorway. Upon seeing the officers, Whitehead sent several people to an adjacent room, which was attached to the tavern. After approximately 2 minutes, Whitehead let the officers enter the tavern. Upon entering the officers observed numerous bottles of beer, shot glasses, and glasses with mixed drinks on the main bar and jackets on the stools in front of the drinks. Four patrons were found hiding on the second floor of the premises.

On arrival the found the applicant standing on a porch, having an argument with two other persons. The argument was loud, involved swearing and yelling, and continued even though officers requested the parties involved to calm down. The officer located the owner and had him properly park it on the street. The officers then conducted a tavern check and spoke with Betty WHITEHEAD, the wife of the agent. She stated there were no problems at the tavern.

21. On 03/31/2019 at 10:26pm officers were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at Ret Lounge, 3400 N. Holton St. The caller stated there was an argument and subjects were shooting at his car, which caused him to flee striking a pedestrian. While on scene the caller returned and spoke with the officers. He stated he was inside Ret Lounge and was attempting to use the bathroom. He was told by a member of a motorcycle club that he could not use the bathroom because the club president was using it. An argument ensued and the caller decided to leave. Outside he stated he heard 5 gunshots and he fled in his auto and he was unsure if he struck someone. The officer did not find evidence of shots fired. The bartender, Betty McKNIGHT-WHITEHEAD, stated they did have cameras but she was unsure how to operate them. The officer was able to view the video but determined the low quality picture would not be useful to the investigation.

22. On 04/21/2019 at 1:48am officers were dispatched to Shots Fired outside of Ret Lounge with 50 to 70 people fighting. When the officers arrived they stopped a subject getting into a car and found him to be in possession of a handgun. During a Mirandized interview the subject stated there was an argument involving his wife's friend and the bar owner. The fight became physical between the wife's friend and the owners sister. The fight moved outside where someone yelled that "They had a gun". Believing the other side had a gun the subject's wife grabbed her gun from her purse. The subject grabbed the gun from his wife because he knows the owner is former military and would shoot if he saw a firearm. At 7:47pm the officer went to the bar to see the surveillance video to determine what happened that morning. The staff stated they did not want to look at the video while the bar was open, so the officer should return at a different time. The officers returned on 04/28/2019 and were advised the video is only saved for 4 days so the video from the incident had been deleted.

On 03/31/19 at 10:26pm, PO David LETTEER and I (SQ#5468) responded to a Shots Fired complaint at 3400 N Holton Street (RET LOUNGE). Upon arrival, PO Adam MARITATO (SQ#5490) were already investigating the complaint. According to the caller, states that there was an argument and that subjects were shooting at his vehicle. Caller states that he then ran over pedestrian. Other callers stated that a tan SUV fled west on E Concordia Ave.

While squads were investigating the tan SUV in question arrived back on-scene. The driver identified as Albert L. OWENS (B/M 08/20/59). OWENS stated that he had been inside the RET LOUNGE drinking. OWENS stated that he needed to use the restroom. When he attempted to go into the restroom, an unknown male stopped him. OWENS was informed that the unknown man's motorcycle club president was inside the restroom and no one was allowed in while he was inside. OWENS stated that an argument began regarding. OWENS stated that he decided to leave the bar. When OWENS went out to his vehicle, he claims that he was followed outside by the motorcycle club members. OWENS stated that he observed a bright light from one of the members (possibly a cell phone) when he heard approximately (5) gunshots. Fearing that he was being shot at, OWENS put his vehicle into drive and fled the area. OWENS stated that he is not sure if he had struck anyone while doing so.

The investigation revealed that there were not casings recovered, as well as no other patrons inside the bar corroborated his story in regards to gunshots. Several patrons stated that they did observe OWENS strike another person (motorcycle club president) and flee the area. I made contact with the bartender/owner identified as Betty R. MC KNIGHT-WHITEHEAD (B/F 07/27/60) who stated that OWENS had been in the bar since 04:30pm that afternoon. She stated that she did not think that OWENS was incapacitated or too intoxicated, however she did not hear any gunshots. I asked MC KNIGHT-WHITEHEAD if their security cameras worked. She stated that they did but did not know what the password to be able to watch recorded footage. I observed camera on the screen however due to the low quality of picture, the footage would not be useful in this investigation.

It was determined by investigating squads that no gunshots occurred and that the call was only a trouble with subject complaint.

This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, Late Power Shift Tavern Squad 5468, with PO Russell MACRAE. This narrative is taken from the reports of PO ROMEO and PO HEMMINGS reports and is a summary only.

On 04-21-19 at 1:48 a.m., Squad 5467 (PO ROMEO and PO HEMMINGS) responded to a shots fired complaint outside of the RET Lounge, on E. Townsend St. and N. Holton St., with 50 to 70 people physically fighting outside the bar.

Upon arrival, officers located a subject who was actively attempting to enter a vehicle. Officers found this individual to be in possession of a handgun, as well as being a felon. The subject was arrested. See PO ROMEO and PO HEMMINGS reports for further detailed information on this incident.

While with the subject at D5, in an interview, the subject stated in a mirandized interview that he was at the RET Bar, located at 3400 N. Holton St., with his wife for a party, when there was a commotion between one of his wife's friends and the bar owner. The subject stated his wife's friend became hostile, so the bar owner became hostile as well. The subject stated there were punches exchanged between his wife's party and the bar owners sister. As the subject was trying to calm the situation down, another male was struck in the head with a bottle and the commotion from inside the bar moved outside.

The subject stated he was unsure if the bar owner had her gun on her, when someone yelled "They had a gun!" from his wife's party. The subject believed that the group he was with was yelling about the bar owner having her gun on her. The subject stated his wife is a carry conceal permit holder and his wife retrieved her firearm from her purse. The subject stated he grabbed the gun from his wife, due to her being hostile and having been drinking. The subject believed that shots would have been fired because he knows how both sides are.

The subject believed, that the bar owner, being ex-military and possibly having a firearm, would shoot if she saw a firearm and that is why he took his wife's gun.

PO MACRAE and PO LETTEER did go to the bar in order to obtain video evidence of the incident on 04-21-19 at 7:47 p.m. in order to obtain the video. Upon arrival we spoke to the staff and found that the bar had improved the camera system from the last time we had been at the bar (03-31-19). While there, we were informed that the bar was uncomfortable in reviewing the video with the bar full of people and asked us to come back later to review the video.

We did return on 04-28-19 to review the video, but we were informed that the bar only was retaining their video for 4 days and that the bar would not have the incident saved for us to view. On this day we spoke to Betty WHITEHEAD, the wife of LC WHITEHEAD, the agent of the bar and informed her that we would be filing this report.


