


Neighborhood Cleanups




Canvassing







City of Milwaukee Board of Election Commissioners- Carmen Cabrera






Multicultural Entrepreneurial Institute



After we took a tour and had an orientation at the District 6 Police Station, we helped Officer Felix and Captain Riestra renovate the front garden of the station (give/take).








CDBG Hearing

Core El Centro - Jillian Holy-Skaja




UMOS - Latina Resource Center




Clarke Square neighborhood Initiative Night Ou

Mitchell Street BID - Nancy Bush





Thanks to the officers of D6, we were able to tour City Hall and learn about the the Common Council, the mayor of the City of Milwaukee as well as the building's history.






SOC Graduation Ceremony






Cristina Alanis, Youth Organizing Intern

Dalina Jimenez, Youth Organizing Intern


