- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 04/16/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a subject with a weapon complaint at 539 West Virginia Street (Conejito's Place). Investigation revealed that the business's manager, Jan Juana Gonzalez, called police when she observed a customer, who appeared to have a handgun in his waistband, order a margarita. Officers located the subject inside the business and observed a firearm in a holster in his waistband. They then spoke with this subject who identified himself as a CCW permit holder and stated he forgot that he was armed when he entered the business. The subject did not appear to be intoxicated and agreed to store the weapon in the trunk of his car. Officers then told Gonzalez that the subject agreed to store the firearm in the trunk of his car and he did not appear to be intoxicated. They also told the caller that because the subject is a CCW permit holder and the business does not have signage restricting firearms inside the business, the subject had not violated any laws.
- 2. On 05/16/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a trouble with a subject complaint at 539 West Virginia Street (Conejito's Place). Investigation revealed a patron of the business had accused staff of taking a \$100.00 bill from the table he was seated at. This customer refused to leave until he got his money back and police arrived. The manager, San Juana Gonzalez, asked this subject to return to the business on Monday so she (Gonzalez) could determine if video depicted the incident. The customer left and stated he would return on Monday. While on scene, officers observed no violations.

She stated she did throw food on the floor but it was after the waitress threw a glass of water at her. The officer advised all parties involved.

This report is submitted by P.O. James Knapinski, assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift.

On Saturday, 05/11/2019, at 9:39 P.M., my partner, P.O. Desaray Larson, and I were dispatched to a battery complaint at Conejito's Place at 539 W. Virginia St.

Upon arrival I spoke with the manager of the business, SanJuana Gonzalez, who stated that a group of three female came into the business and asked to split the bill. Gonzalez stated that it was posted that there was no bill splitting and it was posted. Gonzalez then stated that there was a B/F in the group that was being rude and using racial slurs towards her staff. Gonzalez stated she did not see a battery between her staff and the group and just wished for them to leave.

I then spoke with the waitress, Yoana Chavez-Mata, who stated that the group were being rude to her and a B/F in the group intentionally dumped water on the floor and stated "Clean it up, because that's what spics do best." Chavez-Mata stated that the B/F then threw a plate of food on the floor and approached her while she was behind the bar. Chavez-Mata stated she was afraid and splashed water at her. After this the subject left and called police.

P.O. Larson spoke with the B/F, identified as Angela N. Keaton, who stated that her party went into the restaurant and the staff was rude to them. Keaton also stated that the waitress, Chavez-Mata, kept calling them fat and fat ass. Keaton stated when she wanted to make a complaint the waitress threw a glass of water on her and she did throw her food on the floor after this. Keaton did not want further police action regarding the incident. End of report.
