
Dennie Sanchez, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a fully marked City of Milwaukee motorcycle that was traveling westbound on West State Street. As the City motorcycle entered the intersection of North 12th Street and West State Street, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling eastbound on West State Street, failed to yield the right-of-way by turning left in front of Officer Sanchez, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Sanchez, who was ejected from the City motorcycle, sustained injuries to his wrists, right shoulder, left elbow and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$23,519.09.

After reviewing the personal automobile insurance policy issued to Officer Sanchez by GEICO Casualty Company, it was agreed that the uninsured motorist coverage would be provided on a pro rata basis. The amount requested represents 20% of the total settlement (\$19,500), which is equal to the City of Milwaukee's pro rata share. GEICO Casualty Company has paid Officer Sanchez the full \$19,500 and the amount requested is for reimbursement to GEICO Casualty Company of the City of Milwaukee's pro rata share of the total settlement.
