#### Private Ash Trees

- EAB ash mortality is peaking
- 13,000 dying ash trees on 6,200 properties confirmed to date
- Work volume far exceeds staff capacity
- Highest code enforcement priority (Public Safety)
- Contractor capacity concerns

#### City Ash Street Trees

- 28,000 ash street trees protected
- 300% return on investment
