In accordance with the regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the City of Milwaukee has prepared and will submit to HUD the following *proposal*:

 Funding Allocation Plan with proposed funding categories for Funding Year 2020. The Funding Allocation Plan incorporates strategic direction for the following grants: Community Development Block Grant funding, HOME Investment Partnerships, Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA).

Additionally, CDGA will discuss the process for the *Five Year Consolidated Plan for Funding Years* 2020-2024 and the Regional Analysis of Impediments (AI). The Consolidated Plan allows local jurisdictions and citizens the opportunity to shape the various housing and community development programs into effective, coordinated neighborhood and community development strategies.

The City of Milwaukee Community and Economic Development Committee will hold two public hearings to obtain citizen comments on the proposed 2020 Funding Allocation Plan, the Consolidated Plan and the Regional Analysis of Impediments Process.
