
This report is written by P.O. Joshua Dummann assigned to District Six, Early Power Shift.

I met with Jami Markov who is the owner/licensee of the location. Markov stated they are remodeling the location which will be a café style restaurant which will also serve beer, wine and liquor. She

anticipates 80% of her product profit coming from food and non-alcoholic drinks and 20% coming from beer, wine and alcohol.

Markov stated she plans on installing five to seven security cameras which will be placed on both the exterior and interior of the location. She also stated she will be installing additional exterior lighting. As well as adding a patio area which will include additional lighting.



On Friday, June 21st, 2019 at 2:08 a.m. I was dispatched to 3202 S 13th St for a shooting call.

The CAD stated the caller believed someone had been shot across the street from their house. In the CAD the caller stated the victim was lying on the ground.

Upon arrival blood splatter was found out side of 3219 S 13th St, Buckshots Bar. I made contact with the owner/bartender David NUNEZ CRUZ (w/m 03/06/61) and Viviana M. SEDA (w/f 02/24/82). NUNEZ and SEDA were both uncooperative initially.

When I initially started talking to NUNEZ he stated patrons were kicked out of the bar for being rowdy. and yelling, but subsequently changed his story, stating that the bar was closed and no one was inside when the incident started, NUNEZ stated nothing happened in his bar, NUNEZ stated people were arguing outside of his bar. NUNEZ initially did not mention that he witnessed fighting occurring outside of the bar, NUNEZ initially stated nothing occurred outside, I pointed out the blood within 3 feet of his front steps and NUNEZ argued that it was near the bar but not in front of the bar. Later NUNEZ admitted to standing in the doorway and watching the fight.

SEDA initially stated she did not see anything and did not know anything about the incident in front of the bar. Later SEDA mentioned that she heard "something about someone grabbing someone's ass" which caused a problem between the patrons of the bar.
