Dear Mr. Jones:

We are in receipt of your claim for property damages in the amount of \$3450.00 that resulted from a police force entry at 2800 N. 46th Street on March 23, 2019.

We have conducted and concluded our investigation of this matter. Our investigation revealed that on the night of March 23, 2019, Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) was notified of shots being fired in the vicinity of North 46th Street and West Hadley Street. Upon arriving at the location, MPD Officers observed that the address of 2800 N. 46th Street was struck by a bullet, striking the living room window.

MPD officers, following standard procedures, forced entry into the residence to perform a welfare check on possible citizens being struck by gunfire. The welfare check revealed that the residence was unoccupied and that a bullet went through a front window of the living room and exited through a rear window of the living room, exiting the residence.

Our investigation concluded that MPD officers conducted themselves according to standard procedures in conducting a welfare check for possible injuries in a residence that was struck by gunfire. Therefore, the City of Milwaukee bears no liability for the damages incurred from the force entry conducted by MPD officers at 2800 N. 46th Street on March 23, 2019.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a written statement requesting a hearing within 21 days of the postmarked date of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202.
