The notarization on these petitions is not sufficient per Wis. Stat. sec. 706.07, therefore they are not properly acknowledged as required by MCO sec. 295-307-5 and are not sufficient petitions.

I am of the opinion that the original petition is not sufficient, as the affidavit does not clearly state which petition it applies to.

The affidavits are, once again, on City Clerk's office letterhead. Unless your office has some affirmative obligation to assist petitioners, I would caution against permitting petitioners to use City letterhead or otherwise providing assistance with preparing and/or submitting petitions.
