

(1) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907 of the Code relator section 273-707 of the Code feathering to the establishment of planned development districts, the Common Council approves the subject Detailed Planned Development, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File

is attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.

(2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for:

That part of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 27, Township 8 North, Range 21 East, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of
