If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 03/12/2016 Patrick GUENTHER (50% shareholder) was cited for Operating While Intoxicated. He was convicted on 07/13/2016 and his license was revoked for 6 months.
- 2. On 07/06/2018 at 12:25am officers investigated an incident at Kelly's Bleachers, 5218 W. Bluemound Rd. The investigation revealed the waitress attempted to close out a bill and the credit card was declined. She told a security guard who approached the subject outside as he was sitting in a vehicle. The subject became verbally combative and made threats to shoot him. The subject then drove off in their direction, almost striking the security guard.
- 3. On 01/01/2019 at 2:19am officers responded to a battery complaint at 5218 W. Blue Mound Rd. The officers spoke with the victim who stated he was outside of Kelly's Bleachers waiting for an UBER when a male subject was talking to a female in a degrading manor. The victim confronted the subject about the way he was treating the female and the subject hit the victim with a cane to the shoulder and head. The victim then punched the suspect, causing him to pass out. The officers spoke the suspect who did not recall what happened. The officers spoke with the applicant who stated he did not witness the fight but helped his security assist the subject up off the ground and told another employee to call 911. Both of the subjects refused medical attention and stated they did not want to press charges.

4. On 08/25/2019 at 2:30am officers were dispatched to fight at Kelly's Bleachers, 5218 W. Blue Mound Rd. When the officers arrived they observed a subject lying on the ground out front bleeding from the head. The victim stated she was exiting Kelly's Bleachers and observed two groups of former patrons fighting outside. She attempted to break up the fight and was struck in the head with the base of a car seat. The manager, Brendan BUTLER, stated there is a camera on the front door but it does not face the street and would likely not have captured the fight.

This report is written by PO Devin WHITFIELD, assigned to District Three, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, August 25, 2019 at 2:30 AM, PO Taylor ZUBE and I (squad 3441) responded to Kelly's Bleachers, located at 5218 W Bluemound Rd in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin for a Fight complaint. Upon arrival, we observed a subject, later identified as Jenny P HANG (a/f, 08-06-90) lying in the middle of the street in front of Kelly's Bleachers bleeding from the head.

Our investigation revealed that HANG was leaving Kelly's Bleachers when she observed people fighting. HANG stated the people fighting were former patrons of Kelly's Bleachers. HANG stated the former patrons were fighting with another group in front of the location. HANG stated while trying to stop the fight, she was struck in the head with the base of a car seat by an unknown subject. HANG suffered a 5 inch laceration to her upper right eye that required approximately 20 stitches. See IR 19-237-0022 regarding.

Interview of Brendan B BUTLER(w/m, 06-09-78)

I interviewed the Manager of Kelly's Bleachers, Brendan B BUTLER (w/m, 06-09-78) inside of Kelly's Bleachers. BUTLER stated that he did not witness the fight but that he saw HANG lying in the middle of the street bleeding from the head. BUTLER stated that HANG was in Kelly's Bleachers prior to the fight but was unsure if the suspect was also in Kelly's Bleachers prior to the fight. BUTLER stated that there is a camera at the entrance of Kelly's Bleachers but that the camera does not face the street and likely would not have captured the incident. Follow-up will be conducted by the District Three Tavern Squad to attempt to retrieve any possible video surveillance of this incident.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

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This report was written by P.O. Miles KOWALIK, assigned to District 3, Late Power Shift.

On Tuesday, January 1, 2019 at approximately 2:19 a.m., my squad partner, (P.O. Frank YINKO), and squads 3420, (P.O. Mark CROSS and P.O. Samuel RODRIGEUEZ), 3411, (Sgt. Raymond HEWITT), responded to 5218 W. Bluemound Rd., for a Battery complaint.

Upon our arrival we were informed that Jeffrey L. CRAWFORD, (b/m, 2/6/68), and Jordan R. MYERS, (w/m, 5/18/94), engaged into a verbal altercation. During this altercation, CRAWFORD struck MYERS with a wooden cane in the upper left shoulder and head. MYERS while acting in self defense struck CRAWFORD in the face with a closed fist, causing him to fall unconscious.

I first spoke to MYERS who stated the following: While leaving Kelly's Bleachers with a group of friends, they were waiting outside for an UBER. During this time, MYERS heard CRAWFORD speaking to a female in a degrading way. CRAWFORD then looked at him, and stated you want to go at it, while he swung his cane at MYERS. MYERS stated that the cane struck him in the left shoulder area before hitting him in the head. MYERS stated that he then felt threaten for his life and struck CRAWFORD one time on the left side of the face causing him to black out.

P.O. CROSS then spoke to CRAWFORD who stated the following: CRAWFORD stated that the events happened to fast and he could not remember anything. CRAWFORD continued to deny anything happened to P.O. CROSS, and did not want anything done.

I then spoke to Emma R. SCARO, (w/f, 12/1/94), who stated the following: While leaving the establishment, she heard MYERS say something to CRAWFORD. She was unsure what was said, but informed me that CRAWFORD then stuck MYERS with a CANE. MYERS then struck CRAWFORD one time, and observed CRAWFORD black out.

P.O. CROSS then spoke to Gabrielle M. TIMMER, (w/f, 1/7/98), and relayed the following information to me. TIMMER stated that she and MYERS are boyfriend/girlfriend. They were outside of Kellys Bleachers when MYERS confronted CRAWFORD for they way he was talking to another women. CRAWFORD first struck MYERS with a cane, and MYERS struck CRAWFORD causing him to fall unconscious.

P.O. YINKO then spoke to Daniel P. DESSENT, (w/m, 9/3/93), and relayed to me the following: DESSENT called for an UBER to pick them up from outside of Kellys Bleachers. While, he was outside waiting with

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TIMMER, SCARO and MYERS, the verbal altercation started. DESSENT stated that this argument started when MYERS confronted CRAWFORD about degrading a female outside. CRAWFORD made a statement to MYERS and struck him with a cane. MYERS then struck CRAWFORD one time causing him to pass out.

P.O. YINKO then spoke to the manager of the establishment, (Anthony L. LUCHINI, w/m, 4/23/80), who stated that he was unaware of the altercation that took place on the sidewalk in front of his establishment. LUCHINI stated that one of his security guards informed him after seeing CRAWFORD lying on the ground. As he exited the establishment, and was notified of what happened, he requested one of his security guards to stop MYERS who was walking away, while he and another security guard started to help CRAWFORD off of the ground, while informing another co-worker to call 911 and report the incident.

Milwaukee Fire Department, Engine 35, (Lt. Allen CHRISTEL) and med 14,(Lt. Steven BUDNOWSKI)arrived on scene, however no medical attention was seeked.

Upon speaking to MYERS after this investigation, he did not want to press any charges against CRAWFORD for striking him with a cane.

P.O. CROSS then spoke to CRAWFORD again, who did not want to press any charges against MYERS for striking him unconscious.

Neither party complained of pain or any injuries.

Sgt. HEWITT then informed me that due to the circumstances of this investigation to file a report dictating the investigation and allowing both parties to go their separate ways.



Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

On Saturday, March 2, 2019, at approximately 4:06 AM, Squad 3390 PO Daniel GONZALES and I responded to a shooting that occurred at 5524 W North Ave, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

There was a shooting victim who walked into St. Joseph's Hospital who stated that he was shot at the restaurant Scene 1ne, which is located at 5524 W North Avenue.

Squads responded to the Bar at 5524 W. North Avenue and located a blood trail outside the bar that led inside. Force entry was made because it was unknown at the time if there were others hurt or injured.

Multiple subjects were located inside the bar at the time of the entry. All Subjects were detained until CIB interviewed them. The subjects located inside the bar were identified as the cleaning crew after Bar Hours.

CIB arrived on scene and took over the investigation.

The victim was shot in the right hand by an unknown actor after a verbal argument inside the bar. The actor was armed with a black-semi auto handgun and the victim attempted to wrestle the actor for control of the firearm. At this time the actor discharged his firearm approximately 3 times, one bullet striking the victim through his right hand. No casings were recovered at this time.

The owner Devon D. DENT (b/m 11-16-1979) was notified of this incident.

DENT has a valid tavern license (#020636) and is also the Listing Agent. The effective date for the license is 10-12-2018 and expiration date is 10-11-2019.

This was confirmed by WE energies through meter readings and resulted in 5524 - 5526 W North Av (Scene I) having their electrical current shut off. 
