There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Re: Notice of Nuisance Premises

Dear MDC Coast 4 LLC:

This letter is notice to you that the Milwaukee Chief of Police, by the chief's designee, the district commander, has determined that the premises located at 1433 W Burnham St Milwaukee, WI 53204 ("the premises") is a nuisance pursuant to Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("MCO") § 80-10, Chronic Nuisance Premises. As an individual or entity that is licensed or subject to a license in the operation of a business upon the premises, you are a responsible party for abating the nuisance activities occurring at the premises.

The Milwaukee Police Department has responded to the following described nuisance activities at the premises on the corresponding dates, which qualify the premises as a nuisance:

- 1. On Monday, July 1, 2019, at 11:05 AM, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premises to investigate a report of "Trouble with subject". The investigation revealed that known subjects were trespassing inside of the premises and fled before the arrival of officers. The investigation remains open. This nuisance activity is contrary to MCO 80-10-2-c-1-n.
- 2. On Saturday, July 13, 2019, at 9:11 AM, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premises to investigate a report of a "Theft". The investigation revealed that actors removed property without consent and fled the location before an employee called for police. A citation was issued. - 14. On Saturday, July 27, 2019, at 9:38 AM, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premises to investigate a report of a "Theft". The investigation revealed that actors removed property without consent and fled the location before an employee called for police. Criminal charges were referred to the District Attorney's office. This nuisance activity is contrary to 80-10-2-c-1-g.
- 15. On Saturday, July 27, 2019, at 2:28 PM, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premises to investigate a report of a "Theft". The investigation revealed that actors removed property without consent and fled the location before an employee called for police. Citations were issued. This nuisance activity is contrary to 80-10-2-c-1-g.
- 16. On Sunday, July 28, 2019, at 10:36 AM, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premises to investigate a report of a "Theft". The investigation revealed that an actor removed property without consent and fled the location before an employee called for police. Criminal charges were referred to the District Attorney's office. This nuisance activity is contrary to 80-10-2-c-1-g.
- 17. On Tuesday, July 29 2019, at 10:49 AM, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premises to investigate a report of a "Theft". The investigation revealed that actors removed property without consent and fled the location before an employee called for police. Criminal charges were referred to the District Attorney's office. This nuisance activity is contrary to 80-10-2-c-1-g.
- 18. On Wednesday, July 31, 2019, at 10:12 AM, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premises to investigate a report of a "Theft". The investigation revealed that actors removed property without consent and fled the location before an employee called for police. Three subjects were taken into custody. This nuisance activity is contrary to 80-10-2-c-1-g.

As a consequence, you may be subject to a collections action for the cost of future enforcement for any of the nuisance activities listed in MCO § 80-10-2-c that occur at the premises.

You are directed to respond to my office within 10 days of receipt of this notice with an acceptable, written course of action that you will undertake to abate the nuisance activities occurring at the premises, or file an appeal. You may appeal this nuisance determination to the Administrative Review Appeals Board. Any appeal must be in writing and a processing fee will be charged. Please contact the Office of the City Clerk at (414) 286-2231 for additional information.

If you elect to provide a written course of action, I shall evaluate it to determine if it is a reasonable attempt at abating the nuisance activity.

Prior to responding with a written course of action, it is highly recommended that you obtain records relating to police responses regarding the premises. You may obtain these records from the Computer Aided Dispatch System (CADS) at the Open Records Section of the Milwaukee Police Department (District Three Station, 2333 North 49th Street, Second Floor) Monday, Wednesday, and Friday between 8:00 AM and 3:30 PM. There is a cost of 25 cents per page for these records.

Once you are able to determine the type of nuisance activity occurring at the premises, please review the following examples of nuisance abatement measures that you may include in your written course of action to abate the nuisance activity. These suggestions are not exclusive, may not apply to the particular premises, and you may propose other nuisance abatement measures that would be appropriate under your particular circumstances.

- Exchange names and telephone numbers with the owners and operators of neighboring premises.
- Participate in a local block watch, neighborhood association, and business association.
- Attend the monthly crime prevention meetings conducted by the local Milwaukee Police District Community Liaison Officer who can be contacted at (414) 935-7228.
- Monitor the property for evidence of drug activity. This may include observation of clear corner cuts of baggies strewn about, excessive quantities of plastic sandwich baggies found in odd places, presence of numerous weight scales or communication devices and drug paraphernalia such as unusual pipes, empty cigar wrappers, burned hollow tubes, etc.
- Install "No Loitering" signs in the front and rear of the exterior of the premises. This signage permits police to cite loitering individuals in the yard and sidewalk area.
- Install "No Trespassing" signs in the front and rear of the exterior of the premises. This signage permits police to cite trespassers in commercial properties.
- Participate in the E-Notify system for email updates regarding the premises.
- Regularly file open records requests for Milwaukee Police Department Computer Aided Dispatch System (CADS) reports regarding the property.
- Institute a standing complaint with the local Milwaukee Police district station that will allow the police department to remove any individuals loitering on the property.

- Draft and serve a no trespassing order against identified nuisance persons and provide the local police district station a copy of the served order.
- Install and maintain a digital security surveillance system.
- Employ security personnel.
- Enroll in Respect 21 or MARTS program (contact CLO for more information)

If you propose a course of action which is rejected by me or fail to timely respond to this request, and a subsequent nuisance activity occurs on or after 13 days after receipt of this notice, you will be subject a collections action for the cost of any police services and enforcement.

Once you have been billed for the costs of police services and enforcement for three or more separate nuisance activities within one year of the date of this notice of nuisance premises, the premises may be designated a chronic nuisance, pursuant to MCO § 80-10-6, and each and every subsequent incident of nuisance activity at the premises may be deemed a separate violation and result in a citation being issued to you for failure to abate the nuisance activity. Each citation would subject you to a forfeiture of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$5,000.00. Upon default of payment of a chronic nuisance citation you would be subject to imprisonment in the county jail or house of correction for a period of not less than 40 days or more than 90 days for each violation.

Dear Chief Morales:

We represent Walgreens in relation to the August 6, 2019 Notice of Nuisance Premises regarding Walgreens Store 11237, located at 1433 W. Burnham Street. This correspondence constitutes Walgreens' written course of action to abate the nuisance activities that occurred at the described premises.

Your August 6, 2019 Notice listed 18 occurrences described as contrary to Milwaukee Ord. 80-10-2-c-1-g. As you know, all 18 of those occurrences involved one or more of the same three individuals. As a result of the Walgreens staff working with your officers, those three individuals have been apprehended. Since the date of that apprehension (July 31, as noted in your notice) no police calls have been made to 1433 W. Burnham.

Nevertheless, as required by ordinance, and requested by your notice, the Walgreens Store at 1433 W. Burnham will undertake the following course of action to abate nuisance activities:

- 1. On July 31, 2019, Walgreens served a no trespassing order on the individuals, and provided a copy to the District. As a result, no further calls have occurred.
- 2. Walgreens agreed with the District station to have the officer on this beat meet with the Store Manager once a week to discuss store status and strategies for reducing police calls and shoplifting.

- 3. Walgreens Store 11237 staff will attend the monthly crime prevention meetings conducted by the local Milwaukee Police District Community Liaison Officer.
- 4. In addition to the "no loitering" sign posted in the front window, Walgreens Store 11237 has requested permission from Walgreens corporate to install "no trespassing/no loitering" signs in the front and back of the store.
- 5. The manager of the store will participate in e-notify system for email updates regarding premises.
- 6. Walgreens Store 11237 maintains a sophisticated digital security surveillance system and theft detection system.
 - 7. Finally, there is a security guard present at the store seven days a week from 5-10 pm.

On behalf of the store manager and staff, please accept our sincere gratitude for the hard work and consistent efforts of the police department to keep the store, its staff, and its customers safe. The manager and staff appreciate the officers' desire to work together to stop ongoing criminal activity and avoid future activity.

If this plan does not meet with your approval, please contact me so that we can discuss other steps that you or your department would recommend. Walgreens is committed to maintaining safe and secure stores for its customers and the communities it serves.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 9/10/2019 at 9:15 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This letter is notice to you that the Milwaukee Chief of Police, by the chief's designee, the district commander, has received, reviewed, and accepted your proposed course of action for abatement of nuisance activities occurring at the premises located at 1433 W Burnham St Milwaukee, WI 53204 ("the premises"), pursuant to Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("MCO") § 80-10, Chronic Nuisance Premises.

Be advised that you now have 45 days from the date of this notice of acceptance to implement the course of action. The premises will be monitored during the implementation period and if you follow through and properly implement the course of action, no further action will be taken; except that if nuisance activities persist thereafter, you may be asked to modify and re-submit your course of action for review, and acceptance or rejection.

If you fail to properly implement the accepted course of action within 45 days, and a subsequent nuisance activity occurs at the premises, you will be subject to a collections action for the cost of any police services and enforcement.

Once you have been billed for the costs of enforcement for three or more separate nuisance activities within one year, the premises may be designated a chronic nuisance, pursuant to MCO § 80-10-6, and each and every subsequent incident of nuisance activity at the premises may be deemed a separate violation and result in a citation being issued to you for failure to abate the nuisance activity. Each citation would subject you to a forfeiture of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$5,000.00. Upon default of payment of a chronic nuisance citation you would be subject to imprisonment in the county jail or house of correction for a period of not less than 40 days or more than 90 days for each violation.

- 3. On 05/20/2018 at 12:22am officers were dispatched to 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr for a battery complaint. Upon arrival the officers spoke with the security guard who stated an unknown female had been outside of the establishment bleeding from the face. The female refused first aid from the security guard and left in an ambulance to an unknown hospital.
- 4. On 10/01/2018 at 1:00am officers were dispatched to 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr for a battery complaint. Officers interviewed the victim who stated she was kicked out by security and pepper sprayed as she being escorted out. The security guard stated the victim was kicked out for throwing a drink on another patron. As she was being escorted out she was swinging

at the security guards. Fearing for his safety one of the guards pepper sprayed her. The victim then went across the street. The victim went to the hospital on her own to get her eyes flushed.

- 5. On 10/11/2018 at 10:30pm officers conducted a tavern check at Lavish, 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. while they were hosting an underage party. The officer didn't observe liquor bottles on the bar shelf but did see them on the bottom rail. The officer advised the manager, Jeffrey PARR, that the alcohol must be locked up in a different room. PARR was cooperative and moved the bottles. The officer asked if PARR had applied for an underaged party. PARR stated he thought the owner did but was not sure. The officer advised him to apply with the city and notify the District in the future.
- 6. On 12/07/2018 officers investigated a shots fired at 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. The investigation revealed two subjects got into a fight in the parking lot. The subjects fired shots at each other in the parking lot. An armed security guard thought the subjects were shooting at him and returned fire at the suspects. The PNC bank on National was struck by gun fire and 14 casings were recovered.
- 7. On 01/20/2019 at 1:35am officers were monitoring bar close at Lavish, 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. The officers were flagged down by security guard Erico BERMUDEZ, who stated another security guard, had been fighting with a subject. The subject threw a gun which was recovered by BERMUDEZ. The security guard provided a description of the suspect who fled westbound on National Avenue. The officers could not locate the subject but did identify him by using the bar's ID scanner and surveillance video. Video showed the subject exiting the taverns front doors and being confronted by security who thought the suspect was concealing a bottle of alcohol. The suspect is observed reaching into his jacket and throwing the firearm into the air. The manager, Jeffrey PARR, was cooperative with the investigation.
- 8. On 03/19/2019 a meeting was held at District 2 regarding Lavish Nightclub, 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. The meeting was due to a nuisance letter the applicant received regarding recent events. The applicant stated he has hired a new security company and a new security manager. It was suggested he have a manager monitor the VIP tables to better control smoking in the bar. The applicant stated he would look into other methods of controlling the crowd at closing to avoid using Police squads for traffic control. He stated he is seeking an additional partner to help run the establishment.
- 9. On 05/13/2019 at 1:56am officers were observing closing at Lavish, 721 S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr. They observed 38 patrons exit the tavern after the 2:00am closing. They spoke with the manager, Toyona HADLEY, who stated it was her second day on the job and she did not realize what time it was. She was advised of the violation and that citations could be issued.
- 10. On 07/22/2019 at 10:30pm officers conducted a licensed premise check at 721 S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr, which is now named Tycoon Sports Bar. The officer spoke with the owner, David HINTON, who stated the bar was a sports bar, not a night club but he would be having live music. He stated he would have 12 security guards during events, which includes people outside in the lots and inside the tavern. HINTON stated he would not be at the tavern a lot and the officers should contact the manager, Toyona HADLEY, with any issues.

At 2:03 A.M. numerous patrons were observed exiting the premises. At this time I activated by body worn camera and placed it on the outside door of the squad to document the exiting patrons. BERMUDEZ stated Tycoon bar is owned by the same owners of Lavish but they just changed the name. He asked me to enter the bar and see the renovation of the establishment and so he could introduce me to the bar manager and "owner".

Upon entering the Tycoon bar BERMUDEZ introduced me to the bar manager who she verbally identified herself as Toyona L. HADLEY (B/F, 11/24/82). HADLEY stated she will be running the bar and bartenders. She stated all her bartenders have valid bar tending license and she also has a bar manager license which I confirmed via LIRA.

I then spoke to the "owner" of TYCOON sport bar, David L. HINTON (B/M, 06/22/80), who stated he is part owner. HINTON stated TYCOON is a sports bar and not a night club. HINTON stated he will be using all the license that the bar has, like for example live music. I advised HINTON I was the assigned tavern squad and if he has any answer feel free to ask and advised him of the incidents that have happened in the past and that he could prevent, HINTON stated he understands and he will have a total of 12 security guards during events. He stated they will have two security guards in the parking lot across the street and 3 security guards on the parking lot in front of the tavern, one door guy and the rest will be inside the bar.

HINTON stated he will not be at the bar a lot and if we need anything speak to HADLEY.

On Sunday, January 20th, 2018 at approximately 1:35 AM while assigned to SQ 2464, PO Taylor BAAS and I, were on a special assignment monitoring the closing of Lavish Night Club, located at 721 S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr.

We were parked across the street at the PNC Bank parking lot facing Lavish. I observed a crowd forming, creating a large disturbance from the parking lot of Lavish, when we were flagged down by a Lavish Security guard identified as Erico BERMUDEZ (W/M, 12-10-82). BERMUDEZ stated a subject was fighting with another security guard, identified as Justin C. GUY (W/M, 03-01-1989). The subject then threw a gun, which BERMUDEZ recovered. BERMUDEZ provided us with a description of the suspect who fled westbound on W. National Ave. from the parking lot. After squads saturated the area on foot, and vehicle, the suspect was not located.

PO BAAS interviewed GUY who stated he observed a B/M, wearing a gray jean jacket with a black design on the back, leaving the club with what he thought was a concealed bottle of alcohol. GUY stated he attempted to confront the subject, later identified through MPD records as Tracy L. YOUNG (B/M, 08-18-1994), who tried to get away. YOUNG reached into his jean jacket and threw a handgun, with an extended magazine into the air, which BERMUDEZ immediately picked up. GUY stated he was afraid for his safety, and believed he would have been shot if he would have detained YOUNG after he threw the firearm.

We checked the surveillance videos and observed YOUNG enter the tavern at approximately 11:43 PM which his ID was scanned by staff at the door. On video at approximately 1:35 AM YOUNG is observed exiting the taverns front door, and being confronted by GUY. GUY grabbed YOUNG by the back of the jacket, then YOUNG reached into his jacket with his right hand removing a concealed firearm with an extended magazine, and throwing it into the air. I observed BERMUDEZ pick the gun up from the ground, and secure it in his pants pocket. BERMUDEZ flagged us down on video, and as we approach the parking lot I observed YOUNG flee the area on foot until out of view of the camera.

While checking the ID scanners with GUY we located a subject with a photo ID with the name Tracy YOUNG and no DOB. The video was recovered and placed on MPD INV#19002488. The gun and contents

were recovered and placed on MPD INV#19002454. A check of MPD records confirmed Tracy YOUNG was the same subject seen in the video entering the tavern, and later exiting the tavern and throwing the handgun into the air. A check of CCAP revealed YOUNG has an open case for CCW (2018CM002507). PO BAAS will be presenting this case at the ADA's office regarding charges for YOUNG of CCW, CCW prohibited within a Class B premise, DC while armed, and bail jumping.

I spoke with the licensee identified as Jeffrey G. PARR (W/M, 01-27-1991), who was cooperative, and assisted with the recovery of video. Upon making entry into the tavern I could smell an odor of burnt marijuana which dissipated as people left the club.

As Police were on scene, an unknown subject, let a large balloon go from the front entrance of Lavish, which proceeded to make contact with electrical wires at the intersection of S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr. and W. National Ave. which resulted in all of the traffic lights at this intersection going out. Sergeant Jeffrey KRUEGER (SQ 2411) had to direct traffic, and have electrical services respond to restore power to the traffic lights.

On Tuesday, March 05, 2019, at 1:00 PM, Captain Alexander RAMIREZ, Sergeant Chad RADEN, A.C.A. Heather HOUGH, A.D.A. Ann LOPEZ, Alderman Jose PEREZ, P.O. VODICKA, and I met with the licensee of "Lavish Nightclub", Edwin Ordonez, and his attorney Vince BOBBITT. "Lavish Nightclub" is located at 721 S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr., to discuss several incidents that occurred at the establishment.

The meeting began with a recap of the Nuisance Letter that was sent to them by (P.O. Vodicka) on Sunday, January 27rd, 2019. The letter was sent due to several incidents that occurred within the past year. Ordonez was aware of the nuisance letter and of the incidents that occurred. Ordonez stated that since then they had contracted with another security agency, and had a 3rd party come out to conduct an audit on their security. Ordonez also stated that they have a new head of security that has more knowledge with working security at nightclubs.

It was also brought to Ordonez's attention of videos from his patrons smoking inside the establishment. Ordonez stated that he does not allow smoking of tobacco, and it's completely unacceptable to him that it occurred. Suggestions were provided to Ordonez of possibly having a manager for the VIP tables to monitor better than the bartenders. Ordonez stated that he would take everything under consideration and hopefully with a new partner, monitoring the entire establishment would get easier.

The traffic issue was also brought to Ordonez's attention; in regards that several late power squad's would have to go out of service just to conduct traffic control on several occasions. Ordonez stated that he appreciated the assistance by the officers, but understood of our concerns that officers are being taken out of service just to handle these issues. Ordonez stated that he will look into other methods of having patrons exit the establishment without any more issues. Ordonez also stated that he would seek to contract additional security to assist with making sure all patrons exit the parking lot safely and in a quick manner.

Ordonez's final statements were that he does have a lot on his plate, and is seeking an additional partner to assist with running the establishment. Ordonez also stated that he will continue to cooperate with police, and hopes that with additional help on his end no more issues will occur. Ordonez was welcoming to the idea of having our Late Power Tavern Squad come out to introduce themselves and swap information with him.



- 5. On 04/30/15 at 4:00 pm, Milwaukee police conducted a license premise check at 738 W Mitchell Street after receiving a complaint that the business was in violation of the submitted "Plan of Operation" report by selling individual fermented malt beverages as well as fermented malt beverages in 40 oz bottles. Upon entry, police spoke with Omar Ali and officers observed that the licenses for the premise were not on display. Ali was able to provide police the licenses which Ali obtained from a drawer near the cash register. Ali was cautioned that the licenses were required to be prominently posted at all times. Police advised Ali why they were there and officers observed 11 coolers filled with fermented malt beverages for sale, three of which were devoted to four packs of 16 oz beers. Officers observed two "broken" four packs, one of which the missing beer had fallen out and was at the bottom of the cooler, and the other, a four pack of 16 oz Old English 800 with three missing cans. Ali stated this was due to shoplifting. Officers did observe an entire cooler devoted to individual beer sales, the vast majority of which were 20 oz and 30 oz cans consisting of 40 different varieties of cans and bottles of fermented malt beverages. All stated he did not believe he was in violation of his plan of operation regarding sales of individual cans of fermented malt beverages because he was not breaking apart packages of beer and selling them individually. Ali stated that he had to sell the majority of the beers that were in 20 oz and 32 oz bottles or cans because that is the only way they are available but that the sale of these items doesn't conflict with his 2012 plan of operation. All stated that he had started carrying the 40 oz bottles last week due to a customer request. Police checked with a clerk from the License Division at City Hall and were informed by Jessica Celella that the agent agreed not to sell 40 oz bottles as part of the initial application and that the restriction still exists on the plan of operation. Ali was advised to stop selling the 40 oz bottles to which Ali stated he would.
- 6. On 05/28/15 at 1:52 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 738 W Historic Mitchell Street for a shooting complaint. Investigation revealed that an argument over the purchase of beer took place between the store owner, Omar Ali and a customer. The officers asked to see the video footage and the applicant at first refused, then stated there were no cameras. There is no partition separating the clerk from the customers, therefore per city Ordinance there should be cameras. The applicant stated he did not strike the caller, but the caller ran into the door on the way out.
- 12. On 05/04/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 2. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to Quality Discount at 738 W. Historic Mitchell St. The Police Aid gained entry and was able to purchase a 12 pack of Genuine Draft beer. The applicant was mailed a MARTS letter.




