As part of the ongoing restoration / renovation of the exterior of the house applicant proposes to change the flat roofs on the two front bays/oriels to pitched roofs and clad with copper. On the flat porch roof and flat roof of the widow's walk, new membrane roofing will be installed and copper flashing will be installed in place of the prior aluminum termination bars. Additional work will include the replacement of porch floor decking on all porches as well as replacement of all existing balustrades and porch posts in wood, to match the existing exactly.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. All wood used to be of decay resistant species and painted. In the case of the porch decking the wood will be stained.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and <u>must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued</u>. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
