I feel the City's procedure was improper due to the following reasons and I have attached supporting evidence including city employee's names/dates which I spoke to regarding this issue.

I recently received a notice and a bill for a landscaping violation on the property 3815 N. 22<sup>nd</sup> St. I was only given 5 days to correct the deficiency. I feel this timeframe is unreasonable being that it is 5 days from the date of the letter, not considering mail delivery. After receiving the letter I went to cut the grass, and clean the yard to fine that it was done and now I have a bill. I ordinarily cut the grass, but I have a job, and family and sometimes things get in the way.


The reason for my complaint is that I also own 4375 N. 26<sup>th</sup> St as well, which is adjacent to a city owned property 4369 N. 26<sup>th</sup> St. Between May and July, I called the DNS, and my Alderman Ashanti Hamilton office numerous times, to have the yard cleaned, and the grass cut. Only to have the grass cut 3 months later, and the garbage in the yard remains just cut into smaller pieces in the yard. THREE MONTHS! If I, seeing that I do not employ and entire department dedicated to city maintenance (PW Dept.), am supposed to clean a yard in less than 5 days notice. On the other hand it takes the city 3 months after numerous reminders from myself and my tenant to make similar corrections, than there is something wrong with this picture. This policy should be amended to give the owner more time for correction say 15 days from the date of the notice.

We all want to see the city of Milwaukee be maintained and look it's best, but asking someone like me to do a job that the city cannot do in an equal time is unfair and should be reconsidered.

If not paid within 30 days, an additional \$25 administrative fee will be incurred and added to your next property tax bill. If you fail to pay the full amount of your property tax bill, including the special assessments and charges, your property will be eligible for in rem tax foreclosure action by the City of Milwaukee under Section 75.521, Wisconsin State Statutes, or you may be subject to a personal civil action by the City of Milwaukee under Section 74.53. Wisconsin State Statutes

Return the appeal application along with the \$25 appeal filling fee to the Administrative Review Appeals Board, 200 E Wells St, Rm 205, within 120 days of the date of this letter.

By law, written notification to property owners/tenants in violation of this ordinance is not required. As a courtesy, a notice was posted on your property (unless that property is a vacant lot) for compliance.
