Dear Administrative Review Appeals Board:

The law firm of GINGRAS THOMSEN & WACHS LLP represents GOZ FOODS LLC located at 3416 North Teutonia Avenue and its owner, Julia Hautzinger. We are writing to appeal from the whole of the nuisance determination by the chief of police. (Exhibit 1.)

The City of Milwaukee is in the throes of a wave of shootings. The shootings are a predictable consequence of a failure to enact conscientious gun policies and decisions by the police department not to patrol the one mile radius where Goz Foods operates. Both of which Hautzinger has complained about.

Neither Goz Foods nor Hautzinger are responsible for the crimes that occurred on August 5 and 20 of 2019. (See Exhibits 2, 3.) In fact, Goz Foods has assisted the police department in its investigation of those crimes by providing video surveillance. (See Exhibits 4, 5, 6.) It is predictable that crimes will occur where police are not present. That is not a decision that was made by Goz Foods or Hautzinger.

The only information that Goz Foods has about the crime on August 5 is Exhibit 2. Exhibit 2 are computer-aided dispatch notes. The notes say that a man was shot "by a corner store." Exhibit 2 does not establish that the event took place on the premises of Goz Foods and should not be counted. Furthermore, the nuisance notice (Exhibit 1) does not explain how an action or omission by Goz Foods caused that crime to occur.

Goz Foods has more information about the crime on August 20. (Exhibits 3, 4, 5, 6.) Kenvonta Bell, a known criminal, who was out on bond for fleeing police, engaged in a shootout in Goz Foods' parking lot. Further investigation showed that less than 24 hours earlier, Bell was involved in another shooting, aided the unlawful possession of a firearm, and obstructed the police investigation of those crimes. Bell was also obstructing the investigation of his own shooting. As with the August 5 incident, the nuisance notice (Exhibit 1) does not explain how an action or omission by Goz Foods caused August 20 crime to occur.

Hautzinger and her employees are not crime fighters. We submit that requiring Hautzinger, or any other business owner, to make determination about who is and is not a criminal based upon how they look will result in the unlawful



racial profiling that the police department is infamous for. *See Collins v. City of Milwaukee*, Case No. 2:17-cv-00234-JPS (E.D. Wis.) Moreover, it is unlawful to refuse service to someone on account of a belief that person may engage in criminal activity. The Appeals Board should reverse the police chief's determination.

Re: Notice of Nuisance Premises


This letter is notice to you that the Milwaukee Chief of Police, by the chief's designee, the district commander, has determined that the premises located at 3416 N. Teutonia Av. ("the premises") is a nuisance pursuant to Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("MCO") 80-10, Chronic Nuisance Premises.

The Milwaukee Police Department has responded to the following described nuisance activities at the premises on the corresponding dates, which qualify the premises as a nuisance:

1. On Monday, August 5th, 2019 at 4:16 PM, a call was placed to the Milwaukee Police Department for a shooting complaint at the address of 3416 N. Teutonia Av. Squads did respond and investigate. (Crimes Against Life and Bodily Security: 80-10-c-1-k, Discharge of a Firearm: 80-10-c-1-q)
2. On Tuesday, August 20th, 2019 at 8:24 AM, a call was placed to the Milwaukee Police Department for a shooting complaint at the address of 3416 N. Teutonia Av. Squads did respond and investigate. (Crimes Against Life and Bodily Security: 80-10-c-1-k, Discharge of a Firearm: 80-10-c-1-q)

As a consequence, the premises may be subject to a special charge for the cost of future enforcement for any of the nuisance activities listed in MCO 80-10-2-c that occur at the premises.

You are directed to respond to my office within 10 days of receipt of this notice with an acceptable, written course of action that you will undertake to abate the nuisance activities occurring at the premises or file an appeal. You may appeal this nuisance determination to the Administrative Review Appeals Board. Any appeal must be in writing and a processing fee will



be charged. Please contact the Office of the City Clerk at (414) 286-2231 for additional information.

If you timely provide a written course of action, I shall evaluate it to determine if it is a reasonable attempt at abating the nuisance activity. You will receive a written response whether your proposed course of action is accepted or rejected. If accepted, you will have 45 days from the date of that notice of acceptance to implement the course of action.

If you propose a course of action that is rejected by me or you fail to timely respond to this request and a subsequent nuisance activity occurs on or after 13 days after receipt of this notice, or if you timely appeal this notice of nuisance premises and this nuisance premises determination is affirmed, the premises will be subject to placement of a special charge as a lien on the property by the Commissioner of the Department of Neighborhood Services for the cost of any police services and enforcement related to nuisance activity. The course of action plan should not include eviction unless you can demonstrate the likely ineffectiveness of other abatement actions. When investigating nuisance activity, remember that tenants with disabilities and victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking may be protected by the federal Fair Housing Act and Wisconsin's Open Housing Law.

It is highly recommended that you obtain records relating to police responses regarding the premises. You may obtain these records from the Computer Aided Dispatch System (CADS) at the Open Records Section of the Milwaukee Police Department (District Three Station, 2333 North 49<sup>th</sup> Street, Second Floor) between 8:00 AM and 3:45 PM. There is a cost of 25 cents per page for these records.

Please review the following examples of nuisance abatement measures that you may include in your written course of action to abate the nuisance activity. These suggestions are not exclusive, may not apply to the particular premises, and you may propose other nuisance abatement measures that would be appropriate under your particular circumstances.

- Participate in the Department of Neighborhood Services' Landlord Training Program and make a good faith effort to apply the knowledge from the course and attend refresher classes. Information on this training program may be obtained by calling (414) 286-2954.
- Exchange names and telephone numbers with the owners and operators of neighboring premises.
- Participate in a local block watch, neighborhood association, landlord compact and property management association.
- Attend the monthly crime prevention meetings conducted by the local Milwaukee Police District Community Liaison Officer who can be contacted at CLO Phone Number.
- Institute the use of written screening criteria that are provided to each applicant at the time each proposed adult resident receives a written application, and conduct background checks of all prospective adult tenants and residents.
- Institute the use of a written lease for each adult tenant that includes provisions relating to disorderly behavior, noise, garbage disposal, use of common areas, illegal activity, tenant responsibility for guest conduct, and the prohibition of sub-leasing and long-term guests. Timely enforce any lease violations.

- Review the tenancies of all the current residents in the property.
- Regularly inspect the interior of the property to confirm that the residents are your tenants, confirm that the premises are actually used as a residence, and determine if the doors and windows have been fortified or the premises outfitted with surveillance or delivery mechanisms.
- Monitor the property for evidence of drug activity. This may include observation of clear corner cuts of baggies strewn about, excessive quantities of plastic sandwich baggies found in odd places, presence of numerous weight scales or communication devices and drug paraphernalia such as unusual pipes, empty cigar wrappers, burned hollow tubes, etc.
- Install "No Loitering" signs in the front and rear of the exterior of the property. This signage permits police to cite loitering individuals in the yard and sidewalk area.
- Install "No Trespassing" signs in the front and rear of the exterior of the property.
- Install a sign with your name and contact information in a common area requesting law enforcement to contact you if they are responding to a call for service at the premises.
- Record all rental properties owned by you with the Department of Neighborhood Services as required by local ordinance.
- Participate in the E-Notify system for email updates regarding the premises.
- Regularly file open records requests for Milwaukee Police Department Computer Aided Dispatch System (CADS) reports regarding the property.
- Institute a standing complaint with the local Milwaukee Police district station that will allow the police department to remove any individuals loitering on the property.
- Draft and serve a no trespassing order against identified nuisance persons and provide the local police district station a copy of the served order.
- Provide the local police district station with a current tenant list.
- Ensure that all tenants are aware of the Milwaukee Police Department's non-emergency number (414-933-4444) and are aware of when its use is appropriate.
- If there is conflict between tenants, offer transfers to different rental units.
- Install safety, crime-preventing equipment in common areas, such as cameras, motion detecting lights and improved locks.
- Make repairs to windows, doors and lights and improve landscaping.
- Routinely check vacant units for break-ins and trespassers.

Pursuant to MCO 80-10-7, it is unlawful for a landlord to terminate the lease agreement or periodic tenancy of any tenant or otherwise retaliate against any tenant because that tenant complained to the Milwaukee Police Department about nuisance activities on the landlord's premises. Any person found in violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$2,000.00 for each violation and in default of payment thereof, be imprisoned in the county jail or house of correction for a period of not less than 4 days nor more than 80 days.


Once you have been billed for the costs of police services and enforcement for three or more separate nuisance activities within one year of the date of this notice of nuisance premises, the premises may be designated a chronic nuisance, pursuant to MCO 80-10-6, and each and every subsequent incident of nuisance activity at the premises may be deemed a separate violation and result in a citation being issued to you for failure to abate the nuisance activity. Each citation

would subject you to a forfeiture of not less than \$1,000.00 or more than \$5,000.00. Upon default of payment of a chronic nuisance citation you would be subject to imprisonment in the county jail or house of correction for a period of not less than 40 days or more than 90 days for each violation.

This report is written by Det. Anne Portnoy, CIB-Property division, Day shift.

On Tuesday, August 20, 2019, I was dispatched to Froedtert Hospital to meet with the victim of a shooting. Upon arrival, I spoke to P.O. Dan Schaefer/030922 of Sq. 5122 who is on the squad with P.O. Jakob Schmidt/018571. On today's date, he and his partner were dispatched to a shooting at 3416 N Teutonia Av at 8:26am. Upon arrival, they located the victim, who was transported via MFD Med 7 (green shift/Lt. Nevins) to Froedtert Hospital for a gunshot wound to the lower right back. The victim is identified as Kenvonta G BELL, B/M, 12/28/97 of 3158 N 16th St, phone refused. It should be noted that BELL alleged to not know his address. BELL was currently in Trauma C and admitted at 9:04am by Dr. Michael Decker.

I then interviewed BELL in Trauma room C, who stated that this morning he drove to the

convenience store at 3416 N Teutonia to get something to eat. BELL stated that he pulled up in his cousin's white car and was just sitting there scrolling through Facebook when shots rang out. BELL stated several times that he was alone. BELL stated that he did not see anyone and rolled out of the car and crawled behind a car. BELL stated there were approximately 40 shots fired.

I checked in with the scene and Lt. Warren Allen advised me that the video on scene shows BELL arriving with another person in a white car that was no longer on scene. The other occupant appears to be a B/M. Lt. Allen requested that I contact Det. Tucker because this shooting was possibly related to his investigation from overnight - IR#192320020 & 192320030. Det. Tucker stated that he responded to a shooting last night at 2242 N 12TH ST. The victim of that shooting, identified as Kiyell Bell, was dropped off at Mt. Sinai claiming he was shot. Further investigation revealed a shootout at the gas station at that location, but shows Kiyell accidentally shot himself in the commotion. Kiyell is a convicted felon. Video also shows a person take the gun and hand it to Kenvonta, who was driving a white Pontiac G6. Kenvonta took the gun, then exited the vehicle, ran to the store, and returned to the car, opening the door to allow someone to place an object in the car. Kenvonta then returned to the driver's seat and fled in the vehicle with the gun used by Kiyell Bell to shoot himself. Kiyell showed up at Mt. Sinai and claimed he had been shot by an unknown person. Kenvonta was wearing the exact same unique clothing that he was wearing when he was shot this morning. Further investigation revealed that Kenvonta is currently out on bail for felony Fleeing/Eluding.

I then re-interviewed BELL, since I knew he did not arrive alone. BELL continued to say that he arrived alone in the white vehicle. After 5-10 minutes of going in circles, Kenvonta stated he was not alone. Kenvonta stated he was with his little brother, but refused to give his little brother's name. I explained to Kenvonta that the vehicle was gone and Kenvonta stated that his brother did what he was supposed to and removed it from the scene. Kenvonta also claimed that his brother stood around and waited to talk to police, which was also not true. At this point P.O. Schaefer placed handcuffs on Kenvonta per my instructions. Kenvonta then stated that he and his brother "Jayshawn" went to the convenience store to gamble. Kenvonta stated he just should have gone back to his grandmother's and she could have removed the bullet. Kenvonta didn't want to put "Jayshawn" there because he is "on papers." Kenvonta stated that Jayshawn was in the store when the shooting happened.

Det. Tucker was able to send me an image of the person who took the gun that was passed to the car and that person I was able to positively identify as Kenvonta BELL. Kenvonta was treated and released and conveyed to Central Booking where he was booked in on Obstructing, CCW, and Felony Bail Jumping.

I then took custody of BELL's clothing and cell phone for evidentiary purposes. BELL was given a receipt for the following which were placed on the corresponding inventory: (IR#192320050)

- one pair of black/yellow/white jogging pants, size large, placed on INV#19027664, Item #1
- one pair of red Ralph Lauren men's briefs, with a black waistband, placed on INV#19027664, Item #2
- one white T-shirt, Heaven brand, size M, with blood stains, placed on INV\$19027664, Item #3
- one black iPhone with cracked screen, placed on INV#19027664, Item #4

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Sq. 1726, F.I. Douglas Brahm, responded and took photographs of the injuries and the clothing.

On Tuesday, August 20th 2019 at 8:26 AM, while in full duty uniform equipped with a department issued Axon body worn camera activated and in a marked squad, my partner PO Jakob SCHMIDT and I were responding to a Shooting complaint at 3416 N. Teutonia Ave., which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, I was directed to ride with the shooting victim, Kenvanta G. BELL (B/M 12-28-97) in MFD Med Unit 7 (green shift/Lt. Nevins) to Froedert Hospital, Trauma Room C. BELL was initially unwilling to provide his address, phone number or any information related to this incident. After a few minutes of continued questioning, BELL began to explain the incident. BELL stated he pulled up to the above address to get something to eat and put his vehicle, a white 4 door sedan, in park. BELL stated the vehicle he was in wasn't his and couldn't provide information regarding the owner. BELL stated he did not know the make or model and only knew it was white in color. BELL stated as soon as he placed his vehicle in park, he observed a male exit a vehicle to his west. BELL couldn't provide a description of the vehicle or the male. BELL stated after exiting the subject began shooting. BELL stated there was also a male to his east that was shooting back. BELL stated he did not know either male subjects and could not provide a description. BELL stated he was in the middle of a shootout. BELL stated once the shooting began he ducked down in his vehicle. BELL stated he was shot in the right side of his lower back. BELL stated when the shooting stopped, he exited his vehicle and entered the business at the above address. BELL stated he was alone in his vehicle.

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BELL was admitted to Froedert at 9:04 am by Dr. Michael DECKER.

## MIRANDIZED INTERVIEW OF KEVONTA G BELL

This report is submitted by Detective Antonio FITZGERALD, assigned to Criminal Investigation Bureau, Violent Crimes Division, Early Shift, Squad 9245.

On Tuesday, August 19th, 2019 at about 10:45pm, I was requested to conduct an in-custody questioning of **Kevonta G. BELL, (B/M, 12-28-97)**, by **LT. Troy JANKOWSKI**. He was currently being held at the Police Administration Building for Carry and Concealed Weapon.

I went to Central Booking on the fifth floor of the Police Administration Building and meet with and retrieved BELL from Cell R4 at about 11:15pm. I then escorted BELL to interview Room 425F at the Police Administration Building on the fourth floor. Upon entering the interview room, BELL was un-hand cuffed and advised to have a seat.

I activated the audio/video recording system which began at 11:18pm. This system is run through a program known as Evidence.com. This interview then began at about 11:19pm and the system appeared to be in proper working order with video and audio.

The following is only a paraphrased summary of the main points of the conversation with BELL. For the

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full conversation please see the recording from Evidence.com.

Upon entering the interview room with BELL, he physically appeared to be awake, alert and in a calm demeanor.

## CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS

I then verbally read to BELL his constitutional rights directly off a department issued PM-2 card. BELL stated he did understand his rights and would be willing to answer questions. He did not express that he had any questions and had no further questions about his rights that I read to him when asked.

***It should be noted BELL wanted to know why he was arrested and what was going to happen to him.***

BELL stated he was at the gas station hanging out. BELL stated he purchased some marijuana from someone, went inside the store to purchase a blunt wrap. BELL stated when he came out he sat in his car and rolled up a blunt and was smoking. BELL stated he heard people outside his car yelling and walking around and he heard a black male yelling at someone. BELL stated he looked and observed him shooting at people in the crowd. BELL stated he drove away and then received a phone call that his brother was shot. BELL stated he found his brother and drove towards the hospital and lost the car that was following him. BELL stated he did not have a gun, was not at the gas station with his brother and did not drive away with any guns. BELL stated he does not get along with his brother and does not hang out with his brother.

I then returned him to his Cell R4 at 11:40pm and I turned off the interview recording system at 11:50pm. LT. JANKOWSKI was notified.

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

This report was written by Detective Carlo Davila, who is assigned to the Violent Crimes Division, Day Shift, on Squad 9146, People Soft number 009216. This report is in regards to a Recklessly Endangering Safety - Shooting complaint having a Milwaukee Police Incident number 19-232-0050. The CAD # related to this complaint is 19-232-0050. The victim in this case was identified as Kevonta G. BELL, B/M, 12/28/1997, of 1400 W State Street, Milwaukee, WI, 53233

On Tuesday, August 20th, 2019, at approximately 8:30AM, I was directed by Lt. Warren Allen, to respond to a shooting investigation at 3416 N. Teutonia Avenue. Upon arrival, I met with Squad 5110, Sgt. Mejia. Sgt. Mejia stated that there were some on scene witnesses that were present at the time of the shooting. I reviewed store surveillance video which had multiple angles of the shooting events to get an idea of where some witnesses were at during the shooting. Sgt. Mejia identified one of these witnesses as Keshina M. HARRIS, B/F, 06/23/1995, of 3239 N 29th Street, cell phone of 414-982-8868. I located HARRIS who was on scene and asked her to have a seat in the front seat of my unmarked squad so I could interview her about the shooting events. HARRIS agreed and we conducted the interview at approximately 9:39AM.

## INTERVIEW of KESHINA M. HARRIS

HARRIS stated that she was at her home this morning located at 3239 N. 28th Street. HARRIS got into an argument with her boyfriend's sister and decided to go for a walk. HARRIS stated that she walked to "Chuck's" corner store (located at 3416 N. Teutonia Avenue) to get a soda. HARRIS stated that while she was inside of the store, she heard gunshots outside. HARRIS stated that she went to the door and looked outside and observed that there was a victim crouching down by a car, holding the right side of his body with his hand. HARRIS stated that she moved away from the door during the rest of the shooting. HARRIS stated that the shooting stopped and she went back to the front door and opened it for the victim to enter the store. HARRIS observed that the victim was bleeding on his right side. HARRIS stated that she was telling the victim to sit down and apply pressure to the wound. HARRIS stated that she remained with the victim in the store until the police arrived.

It should be noted that I had previously located HARRIS on the store surveillance video prior to interviewing her. The video showed that HARRIS did not walk to the store. HARRIS arrived to the store in a tan Buick four door with Wisconsin auto plates of AFF-9196. HARRIS was observed exiting the back seat of this vehicle just prior to the shooting. She exited out of the back passenger side of the vehicle and went into the store. The store video shows HARRIS walking to the counter, then she appears to walk toward the back cooler but never gets there because the shooting starts. HARRIS runs to the door and is

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observed jumping up and down in a panic. HARRIS runs out of the store and toward the back of the Buick and then to the driver's side of the vehicle. HARRIS holds the open door for the shooting suspect and moves for him to get into the vehicle. HARRIS then closes the back driver's side door and the vehicle drive's off. HARRIS is then observed walking back into the store.

I confronted HARRIS about the inconsistencies with her statement and the surveillance video. HARRIS became confrontational, yelling that she does not know anything about the shooting suspect in the video. HARRIS changed her story and stated that while she was walking to the store, she got a ride to the store but did not know who gave her a ride. I confronted HARRIS that the video shows her getting out of a tan Buick and that it appears that she knows the shooter. HARRIS again became argumentative stating that she could not recall what kind of vehicle she arrived in and did not know who was in the vehicle. I informed HARRIS that she was impeding our investigation and giving false information on the events of the shooting and the identity of the shooting suspect. HARRIS became upset stating that I would have to take her to jail because she was telling me the truth.

I had information that the license plates on the Buick, Wisconsin auto plates of AFF-9196, listed back to a Latoya SWINNIE. I asked HARRIS if she knew a Latoya SWINNIE. HARRIS appeared upset and then stated, "that's my sister". I asked HARRIS why she lied about not knowing anything about the car if the car was her sister's. HARRIS stated she did not know everything about her sister and did not know it was her car. I asked HARRIS if she knew where her sister lived and she stated that she did not know the address. I then asked HARRIS who the driver was, as he was the shooter in the video. HARRIS became angry and stated that she did not know who the driver was. I asked HARRIS if the driver was a boyfriend of her sister. HARRIS became upset and paused. HARRIS stated that her sister, Latoya, is married and does not have a boyfriend. I asked HARRIS what Latoya's husband's name was and she stated, "Marcus". I asked HARRIS what Marcus' last name was and HARRIS stated that she did not know. HARRIS stated that she didn't have any information on "Marcus". I asked HARRIS if "Marcus" was the one in the video holding two guns shooting. HARRIS replied, "you have the video so you already know it was Marcus". I again asked HARRIS to tell us his last name and she refused.

I told HARRIS she was under arrest for Obstructing and she was placed into custody by Squad 5130, Officer Stephen Colwell and conveyed to Central Booking, located at the Police Administration Bureau, 749 W State Street.

On Tuesday, August 20th, 2019, at approximately 8:05PM, I removed HARRIS from her cell on the 5th floor of Central Booking, took her down to the 4th Floor, and placed her in interview room 425H. This room is approximately 6'X 6', has no windows and has one table and two chairs.

## IN CUSTODY INTERVIEW of KESHINA M. HARRIS

3:08 I read and explained to HARRIS her Miranda warnings. HARRIS stated that she understood these warnings and said that she was willing to make a statement.

4:17 I informed HARRIS that I was going to go through a process with her to help identify some people and specifically mentioned the name Marcus, who at the scene, she said she did not know his last name. HARRIS immediately stated Marcus IVY. HARRIS stated that IVY is her brother in law and married

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to her sister, Latoya SWINNIE. I then read and explained to HARRIS and had her read along with me, the instructions on the Photo Array Identification Form. HARRIS signed the form stating that she understood these instructions.

HARRIS reviewed the folders and Positively Identified Marcus L. IVY, B/M, 09/11/1990, as the subject in folder number three. She stated that she was certain that this was Marcus and signed the back of that photograph. HARRIS stated that Marcus is the subject she referred to as her brother in law, and that she saw with two guns doing the shooting. I reviewed the folders and found them to be in the following order:

I then asked HARRIS to review some still photos from the store surveillance camera. The first photo was of IVY inside of the store. HARRIS identified that photo as Marcus. Photo two was a photo of IVY walking from the car he drove to the store walking toward the front door of the store. HARRIS stated that it was Marcus. HARRIS also stated that the vehicle was a tan vehicle but she did not know what kind of car it was. HARRIS stated that she believed that the vehicle was under her sister (Latoya's) name. Photo three was a photo of HARRIS on the driver's side door of the tan car after the shooting. HARRIS identified herself in the photo and stated that she was at the back door of the vehicle where her brother was seated. Photo four was a photo of IVY coming back to the vehicle with HARRIS appearing to wait on him. HARRIS identified Marcus and herself in that photo. The fifth photo was a photo of a black female in the front passenger seat of the vehicle with the door open. HARRIS identified this subject in the photo as her sister, Latoya. The sixth photo was an arrest photo of HARRIS' brother, Melvin SWINNIE. HARRIS identified this as her brother, Melvin SWINNIE. The seventh photo is a photo of a black male subject in the store. HARRIS identified the subject in this photo as her brother, Melvin. The eighth photo was of the vehicle that was parked in front of the store doors. HARRIS identified this vehicle as the one that was listed to her sister, Latoya. The ninth photo was a Facebook Photo of a black female. HARRIS identified this photo as her sister, Latoya. The tenth photo was a Facebook Photo of a black male and black female. HARRIS identified these subjects as her sister, Latoya and her, husband Marcus IVY.

14:57 HARRIS stated that there was another passenger in the car named "Kiarra". HARRIS stated that she did not know her last name. HARRIS stated that "Kiarra" is Melvin's girlfriend.

15:44 HARRIS and I discuss a summary of events. HARRIS stated that she was picked up from her home this morning at 3239 N 28th Street. HARRIS stated that she asked her sister, Latoya, and Melvin to pick her up because HARRIS got into it with her boyfriend's twin sister. HARRIS stated that she left the house before IVY and Latoya got there so that she could clear her head. HARRIS stated that she walked to N. 15th Street and W. Wright Street and then back home. Melvin was on the phone with Latoya and

HARRIS asked Latoya to come pick her up. HARRIS stated that Melvin and his girlfriend were at her house. HARRIS stated that IVY and Latoya came to pick her up. HARRIS stated that Ivy, Latoya, Melvin, his girlfriend "Kiarra" and her, all went to the store (3416 N. Teutonia Avenue).

HARRIS stated that she did not know of any drama between IVY and anyone else. HARRIS does not recall anyone talking about any cars following them. HARRIS stated that she recalls hearing IVY say, immediately after the shooting that someone shot at him first so he shot back. HARRIS stated that she was in the car prior to the shooting and wanted a soda. HARRIS stated that she was not directed to leave the car by anyone. HARRIS stated that after she went into the store, she heard the gunfire. HARRIS stated that IVY probably knows who was shooting at him.

19:31 I referenced Photo number three and directed HARRIS' attention to a white car that was in the photo. HARRIS stated that this was the car that the victim who was shot, had been in. HARRIS stated that he was an innocent bystander. HARRIS stated that IVY was not shooting at the victim in the white car, but rather someone from across the street. HARRIS stated that the victim in the white car is always there. HARRIS stated that she knows the victim to sell marijuana. HARRIS does not know of any drama between IVY and the victim.

21:30 I asked HARRIS if there is any gambling that goes on around this area. HARRIS stated sometimes. HARRIS stated that the gambling occurs in the parking lot, across the street and behind the house across the street. HARRIS knows that people place dice.

22:07 HARRIS does not know anyone that would want to shoot at IVY. HARRIS stated that she does not know of any gangs or crews that IVY is associated with.

22:41 HARRIS stated that she was sitting in the back middle seat of the vehicle when they arrived at the store. HARRIS stated that she was in the middle between Melvin and "Kiarra" who were also in the back seat. HARRIS stated that IVY was driving and Latoya was the front passenger.

22:30 HARRIS stated that she did not hear IVY or Melvin say anything about getting hit. HARRIS did not get a chance to see if there were any bullet holes in the car. HARRIS stated that she was scared and told them to go. HARRIS stated that she has not seen IVY with the two guns before this day. HARRIS stated that both guns were black but one was bigger than the other. HARRIS stated that she thinks one was a .40 and one was a .38. HARRIS did not see Melvin with any guns. HARRIS does not know Latoya's address. Latoya has a son named Christopher who had been arrested before. HARRIS thinks Latoya lives in the area of N. 44th Street and W. Custer.

27:00 HARRIS stated that her dad is in jail somewhere in Sheboygan and has never been in her life. She stated that his name is Curtis HARRIS and is in his 50's. HARRIS stated that she has two sisters. She identified them as Natasha HARRIS, 27 years of age and lives in the area of N. 46th Street and W. Hope Street. Her other sister is Latoya. HARRIS stated that she has three brothers. She identified them as Melvin, and then Deontray HARRIS, 30 years of age; Curtis HARRIS, 34 years of age, whom both live in Milwaukee. HARRIS stated that in case of emergency, to contact Curtis HARRIS, 414-943-1632. HARRIS does not know of anyone carrying any guns. HARRIS stated that she is not under the influence of any drugs or alcohol at this time. HARRIS stated that she takes medications for ADHD and Bi Polar

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Schizophrenia. HARRIS stated that she does not have any physical disabilities. HARRIS stated that she has a High School Diploma and some college for cosmetology. HARRIS stated that she understood everything we talked about and that she can read and write English.

34:40 I concluded my interview of HARRIS and placed her back in handcuffs. I took HARRIS back to her cell located on the 5th floor.

I placed the Photo Array Identification form that was signed by HARRIS and the photo array on Milwaukee Police Department Inventory # 19028271. I also placed the other photos that I showed to HARRIS on that same inventory.

It should be noted that BELL alleged to not know his address. BELL was currently in Trauma C, and admitted at 9:04am by Dr. Michael Decker.
