



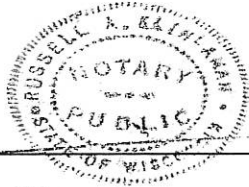

170183 A substitute ordinance relating to regulations for disposition of waste tires.

190159 A substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning from Single-Family Residential, RS2, to a Detailed Planned Development, DPD, for the property located at 7007 and 7007-R North 115th Street, on the west side of North 115th Street, south of West Good Hope Road, in the 5th Aldermanic District.

190496 A substitute ordinance relating to keeping of honey bees in the city.

190508 A substitute ordinance relating to parking controls.

190509 A substitute ordinance relating to traffic controls.

190558 A substitute ordinance establishing a pedestrian mall to be known as the "Historic Mitchell Street Pedestrian Mall" comprised of a portion of the east-west 20-foot wide alley, in the block bounded by West Historic Mitchell Street, South 10th Street, West Lapham Boulevard, and South 9th Street, in the 12th Aldermanic District.
