Re: Notice of Claim for Damages

Dear Mr. Owczarski:

In accordance with <u>Wis. Stat.</u> § 893.80(1d), I am writing to notify you of our claim for damages against the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin (the "<u>City</u>"); the Milwaukee Fire Department (the "<u>Fire Department</u>") and one or more employees or agents of the City. Following is a summary of the circumstances of our claim and our request for relief.

On the evening of August 19, 2017, the McKinley Boat Owners Association ("McBoat") and the Milwaukee Community Sailing Center sponsored a "Venetian Boat Parade" (the "Parade") at McKinley Marina (the "Marina") located at 1750 N Lincoln Memorial Drive, Milwaukee, WI 53202. Enclosed is a description of the Parade taken from McBoat's website.


The Parade began around 8:30 pm that evening, as several decorated and illuminated boats began circling around the Marina mooring basin. The City of Milwaukee's fireboat, "Phoenix" (the "Fireboat"), led the Parade with its two forward water cannons in operation.

My wife and I are the owners of "Wanderer," a 2002 64' Grand Alaskan Flushdeck Motor Yacht. At all times during the Parade, our boat was tied securely to the dock in its assigned dock space at the end of the Marina's "H Dock." A map of the Marina's center section is enclosed for your reference.

At approximately 8:40 pm that evening, my wife and I, and two other couples, were standing on the bow of our boat as the Fireboat approached our boat. Although the helmsman of the Fireboat had the Marina's entire main channel to operate within, for some unknown reason, he chose to pass within an estimated four feet of our boat. When the stern of the Fireboat came amidship of Wanderer, the Fireboat's helmsman put the Fireboat in reverse and gunned its engines, causing the starboard side of the Fireboat to ram the starboard side of our boat.

The collision caused significant damage to our boat in several places, including, but not limited to, gouges and chips in Wanderer's gel coat, a deep scratch approximately six feet long in our boat's hull stripe, and damage to our boat's rub rail.

The collision resulted solely from the negligence of the Fireboat's crew. Our boat was <u>not</u> underway at the time of the collision. As indicated above, Wanderer was securelty tied to the dock at the time of the collision.

We do not know the names of the helmsman or other crew members that were operating the Fireboat that night as they made absolutely no effort to contact us after the collision. They left aboard the Fireboat immediately after the collision without saying a word and did not return.

Fortunately, after the Parade ended, three City policeman on a City police boat came alongside our boat to assess the damage to our boat and prepare an accident report. We did not obtain a copy of the police report.

My wife and I are seeking relief in the amount of \$6,106.31 to compensate us for the damage caused to our boat. In support of our claim, we are submitting the two enclosed itemized repair estimates. The amount we seek is the average of the two estimates.

Please be advised that, pending resolution of our claim, the City, the Fire Department and their respective employees and agents are under a legal duty to maintain, preserve, retain, protect and not destroy any and all evidence that relates in any way to the collision or that might otherwise be relevant to our claim, including documents in both hard copy and electronic form. Without limiting the foregoing, you are instructed not to destroy, diasable, erase, encrypt, alter, or otherwise make unavailable any such electronic documents, data or other evidence, and to take reasonable efforts to preserve same.


