

SUBMIT

Grade sides by driveway down and seed. (Woodstock side)

Grade north side by Terrace driveway and put seed.

Put in stone steps leading from Terrace driveway. •

- Install blue stone flagstone walkway from Terrace driveway to front entry sidewalk.
- Install blue stone patio, dimensions approx. 8 x 14.5 feet, in front of entry on Terrace.

Surround patio with Lannon stone retaining wall topped with a Lannon stone cap. Wall will be seat height.

Install Lannon stone border around plant beds. Install-azaleas-and-boxwood.

Improve lawn whether with sod or seed.

Trim barberry and see if it will shape up, if not remove and replace with something that has some color like a burning bush.

Install blue stone patio, dimensions approx. 11 x 18 feet in backyard. Patio will have a retaining wall at the north end made of Lannon stone and topped with a stone cap. Wall will be seat heat.

DIMENSIONS

South end of rear patio will have a plant bed on the south side to conceal the transformer that is there.

A small approximately 2 foot high fence to be placed on the south side of property to discourage neighbors dog from pooping on our property.

Enlarge existing balcony from 7 x 7 feet to 12 wide (across the back) x 13 deep. Look to be similar to what is there except for a nicer railing around the top in black metal. Material to be similar to existing.

- replace existing rear larp Post of black new fixture

- FIX Chinney w/ lannon strue

- eliminate terrace/woodstack plantings offoundation

Just wanted to let you know that we spoke with the landscaper about the height of the retaining walls that we want to install and they will all be approximately 21" tall. They will be made of up 3 6" tall x 10" wide Lannon blocks that will then we capped with a 3" tall x 12" wide cap. Hope that makes sense.
