## O F F I C E 53206 Impact – Services and Resources Provided 2014 – 2019

Since the creation of ECO's HOME GR/OWN initiative in 2013, ECO has had a strong geographic and programmatic focus in the 53206/53205 zip codes. In addition to HOME GR/OWN, other ECO initiatives like Milwaukee Shines and the Better Buildings Challenge have been active in 53206 or in 53205, within just a few blocks from the edges of 53206. ECO also places a high value on hiring from the community. The solar projects and landscaping projects listed above used local crews. In the case of the landscaping projects, ECO hired Walnut Way's Blue Skies Landscaping which directly employs 53206 and North side residents.

ECO has completed approximately 26 significant projects with 2 slated for 2019 completion in 53206. The geographic distribution of these projects is clustered in the southern half of the zip code, as shown on the attached map.
