Champion Commercial Structures has submitted a proposal that is \$7,000,000 less than the other respondent. This represents a savings of at least 25%. Scope of work:

Goods and services to be provided and rendered by the Contractor include but are not limited to the following:

- Meet with Travaux/HACM staff to assess needs.
- Produce designs for factory-built housing units that satisfy as closely as possible the current Construction Documents (Specifications and Drawings)
- **Construct building components at the Contractor's factory according to approved designs.**
- Produce completed housing units that include all completed interior finishes per current

Construction Documents (Specifications and Drawings), including but not limited to: interior and exterior doors and specified hardware; lighting fixtures, kitchen cabinets, and associated plumbing fixtures; bathrooms with cabinets and associated plumbing fixtures; finished flooring; finished and painted wall and ceiling drywall; all necessary electrical distribution including switches, outlets, light fixtures, bath fans, stove hoods, and fully wired breaker panel; complete ducted system and grilles for distribution of forced-air heat and air conditioning; telephone and cable wiring to each room terminated in single location under the first floor sheathing; stair and associated wall for basement stairs; wood foundation bearing/sister wall between units.

Produce completed housing units with weather and air-tight exterior per specifications and details, including but not limited: completed roofing/fascia/soffit on main roof; front and rear porches, including completed roofing/fascia/soffit; cementitious blocking for installed exterior outlets, fixtures, and air conditioning disconnect.

Coordinate, deliver, and install building components on foundations provided by Travaux/HACM. Contractor shall provide all necessary services associated with transportation, site coordination, and delivery/installation (e.g. road access, barricades, staging, crane positioning, coordination with public utilities, etc.).
