This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 02/24/2019 at 2:26am officers investigated a theft of firearm at On Your Way Home, 2079 S 8<sup>th</sup> St. The victim stated he had a gun visible in his pocket while at the tavern. Near closing time the victim got into an argument with two unknown subjects. One of the subjects grabbed the victim's gun and took it, which caused a physical fight. The victim fled the scene when he could not retrieve his gun and the suspects also fled the scene. The applicant stated there is video inside the tavern but she was not able to view it due to a technical problem.
- 2. On 02/24/2019 at 4:16am while investigating a theft of gun complaint at On Your Way Home, 2079 S 8<sup>th</sup> St, officers observed a shell casing on the ground outside the bar. The applicant stated the night prior, at about 8:00pm, she had kicked out a disorderly patron and then heard a gunshot outside. The subject attempted to get back in the bar but was escorted out by other patrons and did not return.
- 3. On 06/25/2019 at 3:46am officers investigated a battery DV complaint. The victim of that incident stated she was at on Your Way Home, 2079 S 8<sup>th</sup> St. At about 1:14am her boyfriend got into a fight with a male subject and she got into a fight with the girlfriend of that subject. Her boyfriend ran into the business and the boyfriend of the girl she was fighting grabbed a gun and struck her to the head with it. He then pointed the gun at her. She was able to return to the tavern and the suspects fled the scene. The applicant came to the scene and provided the video of the incident to the officers.

4. On 07/30/2019 at 4:44am officers investigated a damage to property at 2079 S 8<sup>th</sup> St. The upstairs tenant called and stated he heard glass breaking downstairs. The officers found the window broken and called the applicant. She arrived on scene and stated it appeared no one entered and nothing was missing. She was not able to access the video at this time and stated she would try and email the officers the video at a later time.

This report was written by PO Eric Robillard assigned to District Two Late Shift.

On Sunday, 02/24/2019 at 2:26 AM, Squad 2340 (myself and PO Thomas Slowinski) was dispatched to investigate a strong arm robbery of a 9MM firearm complaint at On Your Way Home Bar located at 2079 S. 8th St., which is located within the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arriving on scene, we were informed by victim, Henry Scott (B/M, 01-01-73) that he had his firearm visibly showing from his jacket pocket while in On My Way Home tavern. Towards bar closing time, Scott was involved in a verbal argument with two unknown black male subjects. One of the unknown subjects grabbed Scott's firearm out of his pocket which caused a physical fight to ensue. Scott was unable to retrieve his firearm and in fear, he ran out of the tavern. The unknown black male dropped the magazine to Scott's firearm near the pool table of the tavern as both suspects retreated from the tavern in an unknown direction with Scott's firearm.

The tavern had surveillance cameras inside that were operational but the Owner, Debi Damron was unable to play back the footage on her cell phone due to technical problems. Damron stated the building owner had access to the footage on the hard drive but the hard drive was locked away in one the buildings apartments.

Damron stated that she had seen the two unknown black males in the tavern once or twice before and that they were never a problem. Damron did not know their names though.

#### INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report was written by PO Eric Robillard assigned to District Two Late Shift.

On Sunday, 02/24/2019 at 4:16 AM while investigating a strong arm robbery of a 9MM firearm complaint at On Your Way Home Bar located at 2079 S. 8th St., which is located within the City and County of Milwaukee. While on scene my partner, Thomas Slowinski, observed a spent silver Hornady .380 caliber bullet casing on the ground approximately fifty feet west of the intersection of West Becher St. and South Eighth Street lying on the sidewalk adjacent to the bar. We were informed by the bar owner, Debi Damron, W/F, 02/22/60, that on 02/23/19 at approximately 8:00 PM, she kicked out a patron she only knew as "Brian" for being disorderly in the bar. Damron described "Brian" as a Hispanic male in his 30's, 6'00", approximately 240 lbs, wearing a red baseball cap and a red and white shirt. Damron stated that shortly after "Brian" was ejected from the bar she heard a gunshot outside of the bar and an unknown patron entered the bar and stated a Hispanic male, matching "Brian's" description just fired a gun outside of the bar. Damron stated that "Brian" entered the bar shortly after she was told about the gunshot demanding to be let back inside. Damron stated that three or four males that "looked like bikers" pushed "Brian" out of the bar and he left the area. Damron did not see "Brian" in possession of a firearm during the incident. Damron stated that "Brian" did not return to the bar for the rest of the evening. Damron was unable to access the video system stating that the building owner was in possession of the DVR and password to the system and that her phone would not load play back at the time.

This report is written by P.O. Daniel CLIFFORD, assigned to District Two, late shift. (During this assignment I was in full duty uniform equipped with an axon body worn camera activated and in a marked squad car 529.) This investigation is related to IR# 19-176-0017.

On Tuesday, June 25th, 2019 at 3:46 A.M., Squad 2327 (P.O. Jordan YOUNG and I) was dispatched to investigate Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous weapon, at 2079 S. 8th St., located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

Upon arrival, P.O. YOUNG interviewed the victim, identified as Karina M. RODRIGUEZ (W/F 01-09-96 MPD ID#545149). RODRIGUEZ stated that on 06/25/2019, at approximately 1:14 A.M., she was at a tavern, "On My Way Home Bar (2079 S. 8th St). The victim's boyfriend, Eric E. BUSH (B/M 03/11/1982) was involved in a fight with an unknown suspect outside of the tavern. The victim became involved in a mutual fight with an unknown white female (girlfriend of suspect #1).

Eric retreated back into the bar leaving the victim outside. Suspect #1 got involved in the female fight and began to batter the victim by hitting her in the head. Suspect #1 retrieved an unknown firearm and hit the victim in the head with it, causing pain. The victim claimed her ears immediately started ringing from getting hit in the head with the gun. The victim claimed she believed the gun discharged during this incident. Suspect 1 then pointed the unknown type of firearm at the victim. The victim returned to the tavern and suspect fled in unknown direction.

These acts were intentionally and without consent.

Victim is highly intoxicated. The victim did not call police and was not going to report the incident. The victim disclosed the incident during a battery DV investigation IR# 19-176-0017.

The tavern was closed during the investigation but there are exterior cameras. No witnesses at this time. Eric Bush is uncooperative with the investigation

On June 26th, 2019 at 1:00 A.M., Squad 2326 (P.O. Nicholas WILCKENS and I) conducted follow up at 2079 S. 8th ST (On My Way Home Bar), located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI. The bartender, Michele SERDYNSKI (11/29/1969) was bar tending. She provided me with a copy of her valid bartenders license. Michele cooperated with the investigation and called the owner Debi DAMRON to the scene so I could view video. Debi DAMRON (W/F 02/22/1960) arrived on scene and allowed me to review video of

this alleged incident. I briefly viewed the video on her cell phone. The camera view was from an exterior camera facing south west of the 800 block of W. Becher St. The video did show the above incident occur.

Debi was able to email the video to me. I was then able to download the video onto a DVD. I then inventoried the DVD under MPD Inventory # 19020735. I made a copy of this DVD and placed it in the District Two DVD surveillance file cabinet.

MPD Squad#230, equipped with body worn camera), was dispatched to the address of 2079 S. 8th St., which is in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin to investigate an injured person sick complaint.

Upon arrival, I observed a broken double-pane glass window on the East side of the building and a Hispanic male who identifed himself as Raul FLORES (W/M, 08-10-62) standing outside of the bar.

#### Interview of Raul FLORES (W/M, 08-10-62)

I spoke with the caller of the upper unit Raul FLORES (W/M, 08-10-62) who stated that this morning around 4:30AM he was woken up to loud banging coming from the downstairs bar. FLORES stated that he heard glass break after the second loud bang. FLORES said that he got out of his bed and turned on the light and looked out the window but did not see anyone outside. FLORES stated that he didn't know if he might of scared whoever was standing outside or if someone was throwing things at the bar. FLORES said that he then came downstairs and noticed all the glass on the ground and the broken window.

FLORES said he then called 911 and the bar owner who he only knew as "Wednesday" to inform her about what had happened.

FLORES had no further information.

## Interview of Debi DARMON (W/F, 02-22-60)

DAMRON stated that she had worked earlier today from 2PM until close. DAMRON said she had just gone home after closing and cleaning the bar. DAMRON said that before she left the area she set and armed the alarm on at 3:45AM.

DAMRON stated that there are security cameras in the building, but while on scene DAMRON was having issues with her security camera system and informed me that she could not retrieve the footage and was going to attempt to email it to me at a later time.

DAMRON said she does not have insurance on the building and has never had any problems with anyone since she's been in business, DAMRON has owned the business since August of 2018. DAMRON stated that she did not suspect any disgruntled customers or any rival businesses.

After the building was cleared and making sure it was safe for the owner to enter, DAMRON was looking from the outside and she stated that nothing looked to be missing. DAMRON confirmed that nothing was moved or taken after she was allowed inside. DAMRON said that her "Chicago Bears" teddy bear was still sitting at the ledge of the window frame that was broken along with the computer and chip display rack. DAMRON stated that if someone really wanted to take any of the items they could of done so easily, but nothing was taken or moved.

DAMRON had no further information regarding the incident.



- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


3. On 05/20/2018 at 12:22am officers were dispatched to 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr for a battery complaint. Upon arrival the officers spoke with the security guard who stated an unknown female had been outside of the establishment bleeding from the face. The female refused first aid from the security guard and left in an ambulance to an unknown hospital.

4. On 10/01/2018 at 1:00am officers were dispatched to 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr for a battery complaint. Officers interviewed the victim who stated she was kicked out by security and pepper sprayed as she being escorted out. The security guard stated the victim was kicked out for throwing a drink on another patron. As she was being escorted out she was swinging

at the security guards. Fearing for his safety one of the guards pepper sprayed her. The victim then went across the street. The victim went to the hospital on her own to get her eyes flushed.

- 5. On 10/11/2018 at 10:30pm officers conducted a tavern check at Lavish, 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. while they were hosting an underage party. The officer didn't observe liquor bottles on the bar shelf but did see them on the bottom rail. The officer advised the manager, Jeffrey PARR, that the alcohol must be locked up in a different room. PARR was cooperative and moved the bottles. The officer asked if PARR had applied for an underaged party. PARR stated he thought the owner did but was not sure. The officer advised him to apply with the city and notify the District in the future.
- 6. On 12/07/2018 officers investigated a shots fired at 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. The investigation revealed two subjects got into a fight in the parking lot. The subjects fired shots at each other in the parking lot. An armed security guard thought the subjects were shooting at him and returned fire at the suspects. The PNC bank on National was struck by gun fire and 14 casings were recovered.
- 7. On 01/20/2019 at 1:35am officers were monitoring bar close at Lavish, 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. The officers were flagged down by security guard Erico BERMUDEZ, who stated another security guard, had been fighting with a subject. The subject threw a gun which was recovered by BERMUDEZ. The security guard provided a description of the suspect who fled westbound on National Avenue. The officers could not locate the subject but did identify him by using the bar's ID scanner and surveillance video. Video showed the subject exiting the taverns front doors and being confronted by security who thought the suspect was concealing a bottle of alcohol. The suspect is observed reaching into his jacket and throwing the firearm into the air. The manager, Jeffrey PARR, was cooperative with the investigation.
- 8. On 03/19/2019 a meeting was held at District 2 regarding Lavish Nightclub, 721 S Cesar E. Chavez Dr. The meeting was due to a nuisance letter the applicant received regarding recent events. The applicant stated he has hired a new security company and a new security manager. It was suggested he have a manager monitor the VIP tables to better control smoking in the bar. The applicant stated he would look into other methods of controlling the crowd at closing to avoid using Police squads for traffic control. He stated he is seeking an additional partner to help run the establishment.
- 9. On 05/13/2019 at 1:56am officers were observing closing at Lavish, 721 S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr. They observed 38 patrons exit the tavern after the 2:00am closing. They spoke with the manager, Toyona HADLEY, who stated it was her second day on the job and she did not realize what time it was. She was advised of the violation and that citations could be issued.
- 10. On 07/22/2019 at 10:30pm officers conducted a licensed premise check at 721 S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr, which is now named Tycoon Sports Bar. The officer spoke with the owner, David HINTON, who stated the bar was a sports bar, not a night club but he would be having live music. He stated he would have 12 security guards during events, which includes people outside in the lots and inside the tavern. HINTON stated he would not be at the tavern a lot and the officers should contact the manager, Toyona HADLEY, with any issues.






