There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing, Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Fallure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by P.O. Joshua Dummann assigned to District Six, Day Shift. On 7-9-19 at 4:00PM I, squad 6164, met with Derek Donaldson who is in the process of purchasing the property and applying for a liquor/food license as the licensee. The business is

Straight Shots which is a tavern, which serves food and is located at 1503 E. Oklahoma Av. I conducted a CPTED survey at the location and walked throughout the property with Donaldson.

During the walkthrough I observed three exterior security cameras and three interior security cameras which were operating. Mr. Donaldson stated after purchasing the property he plans on adding additional cameras to the location. He stated he currently works as the manager of the bar and plans on running the establishment in a similar fashion after taking over as owner.



- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.





- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.





On March 15, 2019, while in full duty uniform, with an axon body camera, in vehicle 501, assigned to squad 6430 with P.O. Christopher JACKSON. At approximately 12:24 am we responded along with squads to a trouble with subject call for service at 3921 S Clement Av. (Scotty's) in the City of Milwaukee.

Squads also arriving included Squad 6390 P.O. Jose RIVERA, Squad 6350 P.O. Andy HERNANDEZ, Squad 6410 Sgt. David PASZKIEWICZ and primary Squad 6342 P.O. Ryan RADISKE.

Upon arrival to the location officers made contact with actors involved outside the restaurant in the parking lot. P.O. JACKSON and I entered the restaurant to speak with the bartender and caller of this incident. We spoke to Aurea E FONSECA (W/F 01-03-1971) that identified herself as the on duty bartender. FONSECA stated she had a male subject that was inside the location having a loud argument with his girlfriend over paying the bar tab. The subject paid the tab and began to walk out of the location with his girlfriend and his father. FONSECA stated that she observed that the male subject was attempting to leave the bar area with a glass bottle of Miller Lite. She confronted the subject and the subject proceeded to hide the bottle from FONSECA by placing it his pocket stating he didn't have anything.

FONSECA followed the subject outside the bar and told the girlfriend and father of the subject that the subject is no longer allowed back at the location. The subject and the girlfriend began to get more intense in there verbal argument and FONSECA observed the subject hit the female in the face area. 

On Sunday, March 31, 2019 at 12:35AM Squad 6330 (P.O. Matthew PAGELSDORF and P.O. Rafael LOPEZ) and Squad 6390 (P.O. Nicholas COCA), in full duty uniform, equipped with Axon Flex 2 Body Cameras and operating a marked MPD squad car, were dispatched to El Relajo located at 733 W Oklahoma Ave for a tavern violation call for service. The anonymous caller indicated that underage subjects were in the bar and drinking.

A check of identification in the bar showed that all patrons inside the establishment were of legal drinking age.

El Relajo LLC is a Class B Tavern, license #0206646 expiring 4-2-19 registered to Jose S VIDRIO (w/m, 09-13-68) who was not present at the bar. Hugo O DIAZ PINEDA (w/m, 01-14-79) identified himself as the bar manager. DIAZ PINEDA was not listed on the tavern license and could not produce a bar manager license or class D operator's license. Citlali PICHARDO CASTRO (w/f, 11-30-75) was bartending and could not produce a valid class D operator's license.

VIDRIO arrived at the bar while we were on scene and identified DIAZ PINEDA as a licensed bar manager. VIDRIO was informed that a license for DIAZ PINEDA would need to be verified as he could not produce one. A check on the City of Milwaukee website, that was conducted on 4-8-19, revealed that DIAZ PINEDA does not posses a bar manager or class D operator license.

Follow up was conducted on 4-11-19 and it was verified that the tavern license was renewed and now expires on 4-2-20. The licensed agent or a licensed bar manager was not present at the premises. VIDRIO was issued citation J980VXM84C for ordinance 90-8-1, responsible person upon licensed premises which was mailed. DIAZ PINEDA was issued citation J980VXM84D for ordinance 90-4-10-a, Class D bartender license required that was issued in person during this follow up. PICHARDO CASTRO was issued citation J980VXM84F for ordinance 90-4-10-a, Class D bartender license required which was mailed on 4-11-19.

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On Sunday, September 15th 2019 at approximately 2:03 AM, P.O. Christopher Moore and I (Squad 6420) along with Squad 6450 (P.O. James Dauer/Emily Markert) and 6411 (Sgt. Cassandra Benitez) while in full uniforms with body camera's affixed performed a Tavern Check and El Relajo Club (733 W. Oklahoma Ave. in the city and county of Milwaukee, WI.). All squads were in clearly marked MPD Squads equipped with MDVR's (CAD 19-258-0236).

Upon arriving on scene, I observed multiple people congregating on the sidewalk affront of the business. As we approached in our clearly marked squads all persons standing outside entered the bar/club and locked the main entry door.

As we attempted to enter the bar/club for a tavern check I physically observed the main entry door locked. Upon knocking on the door, a security officer, later identified as Janette VEGA-AYALA (h/f, 11/14/1973) briefly opened the door and acknowledged our uniform presence. I explained to VEGA-AYALA we were in the process of performing official Police business as a Tavern Check and VEGA-AYALA reluctantly open the door, allowing us entrance.

Upon entering the bar area, I observed multiple patrons seated at the bar and on the makeshift dance floor. I observed music being played for a laptop computer on the bar and through a speaker system. I made contact with Hugo O. DIAZ-PINEDA (h/m, 01/14/1979) whom identified himself as the on-staff Manager.

DIAZ-PINEDA stated to me the bar has been approved by the city of an Entertainment license but he did not have the Entertainment license physically on the premises. I explained to HUGO-PINEDA that the bar cannot have the front/main entry door in the locked position and he stated he would speak with the contracted Security Officer regarding.

Upon performing a walk-through of the premises, I observed the rear exit door to have a metal latch and

This report was written by Milwaukee Police Officer James DAUER assigned to District 6, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, September 15, 2019 at 2:00 AM, Officers Will DEL MORAL, Christopher MOORE, Emily MARKERT, Police Sergeant Cassandra BENITEZ and myself, conducted a Tavern Check of El Relajo which is located at 733 W. Oklahoma Ave.

Upon arrival, while parking Officers observed a group of patrons outside of the front entrance door scramble to get inside of the bar. While walking up to the bar, Officers could hear loud music emitting from the interior of the bar. Upon trying to enter the bar, the front door was locked. Officers had to knock loud and hard with a metal police baton to get someone to answer the door. Alpha Public Security Guard answered the door and identified herself as Janette VEGA-AYALA (H/F,11-14-73). Officers asked VEGA-AYALA why the door was locked during bar operating hours to which she replied that they did not want any more patrons entering the bar after 2:00 AM so she locked the door. It should be noted that VEGA-AYALA initially stated that she did not speak English. Once inside of the bar, Officers encountered loud music being played which was controlled by a laptop computer located on the bar counter.

During further observation, I observed the rear Emergency Exit door to be locked with a padlock which would prevent patrons to escape safely during the event of a fire or other emergency. This tavern check encounter as well as the above violation was captured on my body camera as well as all other officer's body camera. Sgt. BENITEZ who is my direct Supervisor, also observed the violation.

The Tavern Agent Jose S. VIDRIO (H/M, 9-13-68, of 3573 S. 46th St. #881-4277) was not on-scene to speak with but I was able to speak with VIDRIO on Friday, September 20, 2019 at approximately 9:30 PM, I spoke with VIDRIO by phone. VIDRIO and I had a very civil and pleasant phone contact. VIDRIO was cooperative with me but was notified that he was being given a citation for the above violation. VIDRIO expressed his displeasure for being cited and assured me that the above violation would be addressed and corrected with his employees. VIDRIO did give me a reason why the front entrance door was locked which was he wanted patrons to stop coming in at 2:00 AM due to the fact that they would be closing in 30 minutes (2:30 AM). VIDRIO did not provide an explanation why the group of patrons scrambled inside and locked the door behind them as Officers pulled up. VIDRIO offered no explanation why the rear emergency exit door was padlocked shut during hours of operation.

I issued a Citation to VIDRIO for Safe Egress from all doors/Serving Rooms, Ordinance Number 90-27-1 -d, Citation Number 068272BC3J.
