<b>Description of work</b>	Remove the existing neon components of existing signage above the main entrance of the tavern. The sign is comprised of two projecting sheets of metal in the shape of a V over the entrance. Each metal sign measures approximately 4' x 8'. Repair metal portion of sign for new signage. It reads "The White House of Bay View" and is in a storybook style font. The individual letters will be constructed out of wood and affixed to the sign. The sign will not be lit externally. Owner has option to remove existing sign entirely.

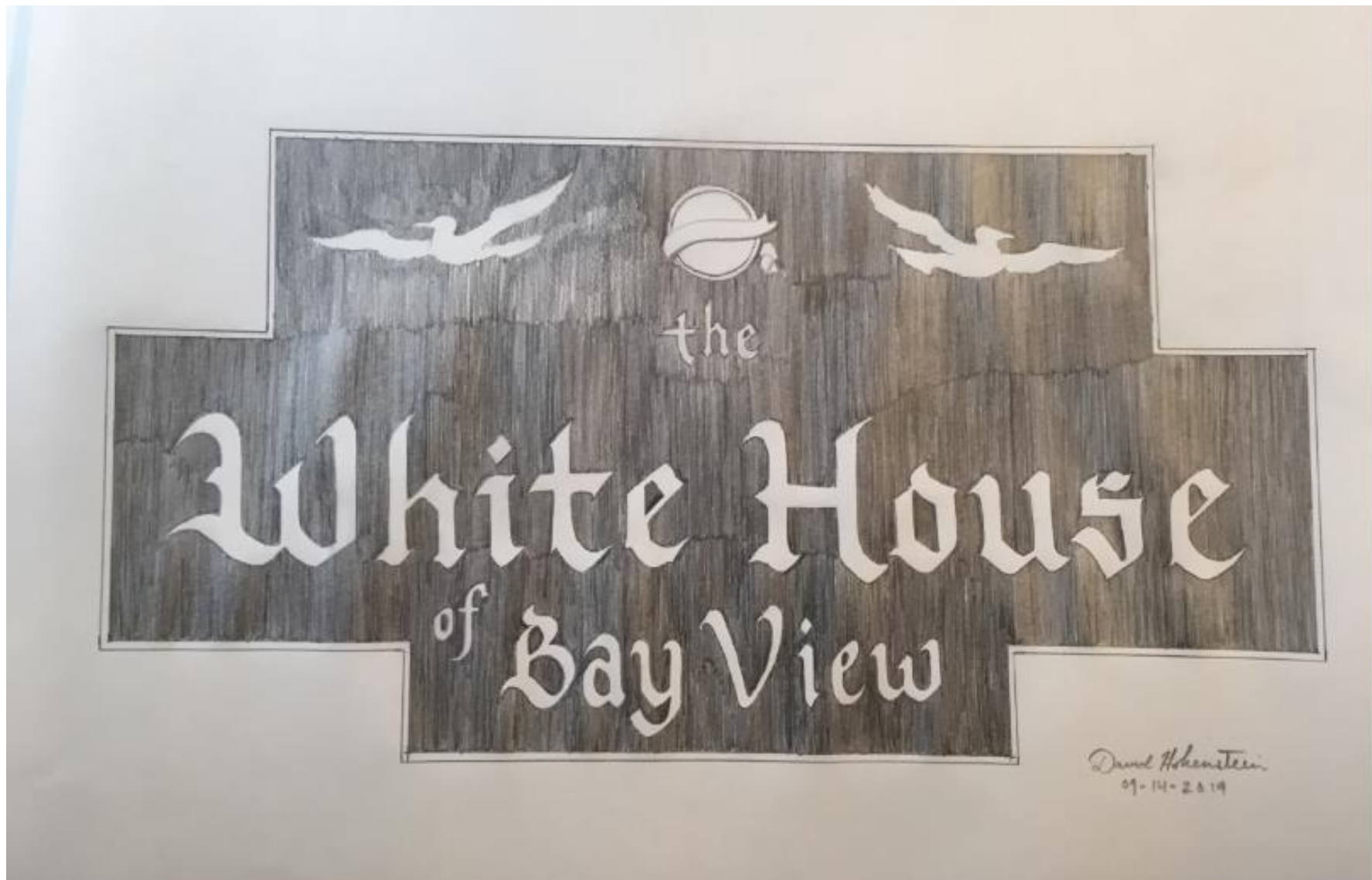
