## **REASON FOR REQUEST:**

Addo Williams, a City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works employee, was in the scope of his employment and standing next to a City of Milwaukee sanitation truck that was stopped in an alley near 3831 North 51<sup>st</sup> Blvd. As Mr. Williams was readying the garbage bin, the uninsured motorist, who was fleeing from the police and traveling northbound in the alley, failed to yield the right-of-way, striking Mr. Williams. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. §62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Williams, sustained injuries to his neck, back and left leg. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$17,560.20.
