APPEAL NOTATION FOR TALL GRASS VIOLATION RECORD ID: PWCF-19-17002

Years ago I hired a local resident in the immediate area of 2501 West Capitol Drive to mow the lawn and he continues to do so, to this date. Normally when I am out of town he mows the lawn and monitors the grounds, since he lives close by.

I was out of town and called him to see if the grounds were okay. It was at this time that he related that he too was not in Milwaukee, but in Arkansas visiting his family. He also said that he would get another person to mow the lawn since he was away.

Unbeknownst to me this was not done; and I was not aware of the grass height. This was during the time when Milwaukee had numerous rainfalls back to back. When I returned I saw the grass and I immediately went to get a lawn mower. I returned to 2501 West Capitol Dr. with the lawn mower and when I pulled up there was two men in a truck with mowing equipment and a sign sitting in my driveway. I asked why they put a sign in my driveway and the reply was, so we can cut the grass I told them I'm here and have a lawn mower to cut my grass myself, but was not allowed to do so because the man they said they had orders from the city to cut it and was adamant about it, telling me I had been notified, as he continued to get his equipment from the truck I let him know I had not been aware of it. I felt intimidated and certainly was not going into a big scene with him standing out on the corner of 25th and Capitol Drive.

I truly felt bad, since I had gone to get a lawn mower to cut the grass and now I'm not allowed the opportunity to do so. True enough, I am a senior citizen, but I could have cut that grass, willing and able, but not allowed the opportunity. They arrived just ahead of me and did not have their equipment out just the sign. I want you to know that this is the first time this has happened, and I would greatly – greatly appreciate it, if this 'tall-grass violation' could be waived. With a promise it will not happen again.

If you fail to pay the full amount of your property tax bill, including the special assessments and charges, your property will be eligible for in rem tax foreclosure action by the City of Milwaukee under Section 75.521, Wisconsin State Statutes, or you may be subject to a personal civil action by the City of Milwaukee under Section 74.53, Wisconsin State Statutes.

Return the appeal application along with the \$25 appeal filing fee to the Administrative Review Appeals Board, 200 E Wells St, Rm 205, within 120 days of the date of this letter.

As a courtesy, a notice was posted on your property (unless that property is a vacant lot) for compliance.
