Here's the appeal language ... the right to petition the commissioner for a hearing within 72 hours

Hearing. A request for a hearing before the commissioner of the department issuing the notice must be filed within 72 hours from the time the vehicle has been condemned and be in writing, explaining why the vehicle should not be removed from the premises.

d-1. Upon receipt of the request for a hearing, the commissioner shall halt the condemnation of the vehicle, pending the decision of the commissioner.

d-2. If the commissioner upholds the condemnation of the vehicle, the premises owner or the vehicle owner may appeal the decision to the administrative review appeals board pursuant to s. 320-11.
