Subject: Veterans Working for the City of Milwaukee

This memo is in response to your request for a summary of how many veterans work for the City of Milwaukee, as well as the number that were hired each year, for the past 10 years. The data available on veteran employees is limited, and this analysis comes with some important qualifications. The available data includes all "military hires," which includes active military personnel as well as veterans. There is no data on the total number of general City employees who are military hires. The yearly Police and Fire Department numbers reflect the number of active fire and police employees hired over the past 10 years, not the total number of military hires from each year. The Department of Employee Relations did not begin tracking military status for general City employees until 2015, and the general City employee numbers reflect the total number of military hires, including those who may no longer be actively employed by the City.




Figure 1: Numbers only include employees that are still actively employed by the Police Department

## **Milwaukee Fire Department**




Figure 2: Numbers only include employees that are still actively employed by the Fire Department
