- 95% of black African American scholars graduate in four years

Summary

Provides health care services to students in an elementary and secondary school setting. Plans school health program, in conjunction with medical authorities and school leaders.

Provides medical examinations and reviews findings to evaluate health status of the student and progress of the program. Instructs classes on subjects such as medication administration, first aid, common child illnesses, health and wellness, and establishes nursing policies to meet emergencies.

Collaborates with social workers, teachers, and school leaders in identifying and meeting social, emotional, and physical needs of students, using the protocols of the University of Chicago Charter School's academic and social support system protocols. Provides first-aid, and maintains health records of students. This is a part-time, benefits-eligible position.
