Proposal	<ul> <li>The First Unitarian Society proposes to expand its solar programming. Two arrays of solar panels are already installed on the flat roof at the eastern side of the complex. The First Unitarian Society now proposes to install 65 solar panels on the south facing pitched roof over the sanctuary. Application materials indicate that the panels will be a black color tone.</li> <li>(Thirty solar panels are proposed for the flat roof of the apartment building on the southwestern corner of the property. This is a separate tax parcel, and not locally designated and not subject to our review. It is noted because it was included with the application for context. The proposal for the apartment building could have been given staff approval, as it has zero public visibility.)</li> </ul>
