## Week of January 20, 2020 Snow Removal Calls- District 1

- 1. 4100 Block N 15<sup>th</sup>: Plow pushed leaves and snow on to property, leaving it impassable
- 2. 4400-4500 Blocks N 22<sup>nd</sup> St: Ice covered, as no salt trucks came through. Plows pushed significant amounts of snow into driveways that were previously cleared by residents.
- 3. 5500 Block N 34<sup>th</sup> St: Plows pushed snow onto sidewalks and against house, leaving walkway impassable
- 4. 4531 N 22<sup>nd</sup> St: Snow dumped in front of her home during plowing and driveway clean up requested on 1/22
- 5. 5500 Block N 34<sup>th</sup> St (repeat): Street plowed once early Saturday, cars ticketed and moved. Plow did not return as of 1/22.
- 6. SE Corner of W. Roosevelt and N. 22<sup>nd</sup> St: Snow piled on apron from sidewalk to street, leaving impassable and blocking sigh line. Not plowed curb to curb
- 7. 4200-4300 Block N. 19<sup>th</sup> Pl: Not plowed curb to curb after cars ticketed and moved
- 8. 4026 N. 11<sup>th</sup>: Driveway plowed in after resident paid to have it cleared. When she called to complain, she was told that "all she had to do was pay again".
- 9. 7100 Block N 41<sup>st</sup> St: Plows never came
- 10. 7400 Block N 43<sup>rd</sup> St: large pile left in front of 7406 N 43<sup>rd</sup>, which inhibits elderly resident's ability to see and navigate the area
