- Re: Report of the Renewal Application of Jihad D. Jackson for a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Jihad D. Jackson (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expired at midnight, October 31, 2019.
- 2. An application to renew said license was filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
- 3. On January 15, 2020, the City Clerk's Office provided timely notice to the Licensee, pursuant to Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and § 349.24 of the Wisconsin Statutes, of a police report that could form the basis for suspension or non-renewal of the license and included therewith a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department report. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the police report on January 29, 2020 at approximately 9:30 a.m. in Room 301-B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the licensee did not appear.
- 4. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:
 - A. Notice was sent to Jihad D. Jackson at P.O. Box 90091, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53209, along with a copy of the police report on January 15, 2020 in an envelope which was sent by U.S. first-class prepaid mail in an envelope bearing the return address of the License Division, 200 East Wells Street, Room 105, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202. The address of P.O. Box 90091, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53209 was the address given by the applicant on his renewal application. The licensee did not appear at the hearing and the envelope containing the notice and police report was not returned to the License Division by the U.S. Postal Service.
 - B. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation suspended the applicant's driver's license for the following:



01/04/2019	6 months for Driving Record
02/05/2019	77 days for Failure to pay forfeiture
02/28/2019	235 days for Failure to pay forfeiture
04/02/2019	202 days for Failure to pay forfeiture
05/30/2019	140 days for Failure to pay forfeiture

- C. A check of License Division records indicates that during the period of suspension the applicant failed to return his PPV license to the City Clerk as required by City Ordinance.
- D. Alderman Borkowski moved denial based on Licensee's second nonappearance.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provide Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and § 349.24, Wisconsin Statutes.
- Based upon the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the licensee, Jihad D. Jackson, has not met the criteria of Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances or § 349.24 of the Wisconsin Statutes to allow renewal of his Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License based upon his second nonappearance.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Public Works Committee that the full Common Council of the City of Milwaukee should exercise its judgment to not renew the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License held by Jihad D. Jackson based upon his second nonappearance.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee recommends by a vote of **five (5) ayes, and zero (0) noes** that the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License of Jihad D. Jackson be denied based upon his second nonappearance.
