Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This Report is written by PO Russell MACRAE assigned to District 5 - LATE POWER TAVERN CAR.

On 02/01/19 at 09:38pm, PO David LETTEER and I (SQ#5468) conducted a License Check at 2483 W Capitol Drive - CAPITOL PANTRY. Upon arrival, I began to walk around the refrigeration coolers to inspect the dairy products as well as any meat products. All of the dairy and meat products were up to date. PO LETTEER and I then began to acquire the license information from the business as well as the name of the clerk. PO LETTEER and I asked SINGH how long he had been working today. SINGH stated that he is not the clerk, and that he had been at the store to cover for his boss who left approximately 10-15 mins ago and stated that the boss would return soon. I asked SINGH if he had been serving customers while at the store alone, he stated yes. The clerk verbally identified as Sukhgander SINGH (W/M 08/31/1993) appeared nervous and was evasive on giving truthful information. SINGH stated that he lived in Appleton. PO LETTEER ask SINGH for his address, due to being new to the United States for approximately 5 months he was unsure of the apartment number. SINGH did not have any form of identification.

PO LETTEER asked if he had worked at the store in the past. SINGH would not answer the question. As we questioned him again regarding when he began work. PO LETTEER asked if he was working alone or had someone else been working with him prior to our arrival. SINGH stated that "he will be back in 15

mins". Being that SINGH was acting deceitful PO LETTEER and I instructed him to stop serving customers until our questions were answered. I made contact with the stocker/employee in the main section of the store verbally identified as Larry M. ROSE (B/M 06/30/57). I informed ROSE of the situation and of SINGH stating that there were other clerks working. ROSE stated that he began his shift at approximately 06:00pm and SINGH had been by himself since he has been at the store.

I went back into the clerk area and informed PO LETTEER and SINGH of what ROSE had just informed me. I told SINGH that if he would continue to lie to PO LETTEER and I, that he would be taken into custody and the store would be closed down for the night. PO LETTEER stated that SINGH did not have a Class-D License to sell alcohol and that we suspected that prior to 09:00 pm that SINGH had been serving customers alcohol. SINGH called the owner on the phone identified as Simranjeet S. BENIPAL (W/M 12/28/79). I spoke with BENIPAL on the phone and informed him that he needed to come to the store in person to clarify the situation. I asked BENIPAL where he was, he stated that he was at home in Franklin, WI. I informed BENIPAL that SINGH was being deceitful and that he did not possess a license to sell alcohol to customers. BENIPAL stated that he would be enroute to the store to speak with us.

PO LETTEER asked SINGH what time he arrived at the store today; SINGH stated 10:00am. I went to the security camera system and checked SINGH's statement of arrival and to see if he had in fact been by himself selling alcohol to patrons. I observed that at approximately 01:00pm, SINGH was working as the clerk inside of the store by himself. I observed a patron bring beer to the counter, and paid SINGH for the beer. The purchase was complete and the patron left the store. At that time, I did not watch any more of the security footage. While waiting for BENIPAL, I informed SINGH that he was not allowed to sell to patrons due to being after 09:00 pm and alcohol could not be sold at this time anyways.

BENIPAL arrived approximately 25 mins later. We informed BENIPAL of the random license check of his store. BENIPAL stated that SINGH did not have a Class-D License, however had taken his bartenders class. BENIPAL stated that he planned to have SINGH go to the alcohol course through the city. BENIPAL stated that he has never been issued a citation and requested a warning on this matter. I informed him that we would discuss the matter and decide if a citation was appropriate.

A citation was issued on 02/02/19 for Violation of Class-D License Requirements and delivered to SINGH in person with a future court date.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 2/19/2020 at 10:15 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


