Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

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

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



This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- On 10/27/07 at 2:18 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 4106 W Lisbon for a Shooting. Officers found the victim on the steps outside of the tavern. The victim was shot multiple times to the stomach, thigh, pelvis area and buttocks. The victim stated he was shot by an unknown actor at 2015 N 41st Street. Further investigation from the offense report filed found that the victim stated he had an altercation inside the bar with the person who later shot him.
- 2. On 11/10/07 at 1:58 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 4106 W Lisbon for a Battery. Investigation revealed the victim was in the Brothers and Sisters Tavern when three patrons began to taunt him and his family. This started an argument and then became physical outside of the bar. The three unknown actors beat the victim severely causing a spinal injury that resulted in the paralysis of the victim from the neck down.
- 3. On 01/12/08 at 2:18 am, Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at 4106 W Lisbon. Investigation revealed the owner, Mary Harrell, was shot to the lower right leg. A second victim was found to be shot to the right side of the abdomen. Both victims were outside of the tavern when the shooting happened.

4. On 02/16/12 at 2:29 am, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check at 4106 W Lisbon Avenue. Investigation found the bar was operating after hours with 69 patrons inside the bar after 2:00 am. Officers spoke with Lashuda Harrell, who stated she did not realize the time and was found to intoxicated. Officers also spoke with the agent, Mary Harrell, who was

cited for the violation. Mary Harrell also met with the Captain of District Three regarding this violation shortly after this incident occurred.

- 5. On 03/31/2013 at 1:52am Milwaukee police were dispatched to Aurora Sinai Hospital regarding a Battery/Cutting. Investigation revealed the victim had been at Sisters and Brothers Place (4106 West Lisbon Avenue) earlier this same day. While inside the business, the victim and a couple of other people had an argument. Around 1:00am, the victim left the bar and was followed across the street by the same actors he had argued with previously. The victim and one of the actors that had followed him became involved in a fight. After this fight, the victim noticed he was bleeding and had one of his friends drive him to the hospital. The victim sustained two lacerations requiring stitches. Milwaukee police incident report #130900015 filed.
- 6. On 06/10/2013 at 10:06pm Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Battery complaint at Milwaukee police district #3. Investigation revealed the victim was at Sisters and Brothers Place (4106 West Lisbon Avenue) on 06/08/2013. The victim left the bar around 2:15am and was followed by a group of approximately 5 females, including the current girlfriend of the victim's ex-girlfriend. This group attacked the victim, punching, kicking and kneeing her. The victim was later diagnosed with an orbital wall fracture, corneal abrasion, traumatic iritis and a concussion. Milwaukee police incident report #131610164 filed.

7. On 05/25/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 4106 West Lisbon Avenue (Sister's and Brother's Place). Investigation revealed the victim, who works as security at the business, was involved in an altercation with at least one patron from the business. This patron struck the victim in the back of the head with a tire iron. Milwaukee police incident report #141450020 filed.

8. On 02/24/2016 the applicant was cited at 524 W. Clarke Street in the city of Milwaukee for Building Code Violations.

9. On 08/02/2019 at 2:56am officers observed a subject sitting on the steps of Overtime Sports Bar, 4106 W. Lisbon Av. The officers observed two subjects approach, knock on the door, and be allowed inside. The officers approached the door and heard music inside. The owner,

Wesley HARRELL opened the door and stated he wanted to have a gathering of employees. He was advised the business needed to close immediately and he complied. The officer observed 12 people leave the business.

- 10. On 08/28/2019 officers were dispatched to St Joseph's Hospital for a Sexual Assault. The victim stated she at Overtime Sports Bar last night and was accompanied by a subject she stated is the bouncer of the bar. She stated this subject wanted her to leave to go to a different bar but she refused. She stated they argued and he then pushed her down causing injury. She stated she did not lose consciousness but then only remembers waking up on N. 38th St and W. Clarke St and not knowing how she got there. She also stated she had luggage with her at the bar that was missing. She first stated they gave the luggage to her outside but then stated it might be still inside the location. The victim stated she was not sexually assaulted but injured when he pushed her. The victim seemed confused and made random statements. She stated she was a victim of human trafficking and believed if she entered the "uber" with him he was going to traffic her. On 09/15/2020 the officers went to Overtime Sports bar and interviewed Wesley HARRELL, who stated he does not remember any problems from that night. The bar has no cameras that could have recorded the incident.
- 11. On 10/26/2019 officers were dispatched to a Shooting at Overtime Sports Bar, 4106 W. Lisbon Av. The investigation revealed the victim was attempting to get into the bar but refused to be searched by security. He was refused entry and walked away. He retrieved a pistol from his ankle and fired shots at the bar. Wesley HARRELL and another subject identified as Christopher Garner (unknown if he was a patron or employee) returned fire hitting the victim in the head, causing his death. The gun HARRELL used had been reported stolen in 2012. The applicant arrived on scene and allowed the Detectives to search but withdrew her consent making the Detectives get a warrant.
- 12. On 11/14/2019 a meeting was held at District 3 regarding recent incidents at Overtime Sports Bar, 4106 W. Lisbon Av. The applicant stated she runs the bar with her children and grandchildren. She stated she has already spoke to them in regards to closing time and having everyone out that is not cleaning. In regards to the shooting the applicant stated that when she arrived the detective told her she could give consent to search or they would get a warrant. She told them to get a warrant after the detective became rude and took her sons phone. The applicant stated her security are people she hires from the neighborhood and the shooting occurred because the subject was armed and was denied entry. The applicant was advised to hire security that is license and bonded. The issue of cameras was brought up and the applicant stated she was looking into possibly getting cameras. The applicant was given copies of the nuisance guidelines and he was advised of the requirement of cameras if the business was declared a nuisance.

This report is written by PO Lydia RIVERA-HOLEY, assigned to District Three, Late Power Shit.

On Friday, August 2, 2019 at 2:56AM, Squad 3465, PO Joshua DOERING and I were conducting a routine tavern check of Overtime Sports Bar and Lounge located at 4106 W Lisbon Ave in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Squad 3312, Sergeant Michael LASSANSKE, also assisted with this call.

We observed the lights to be off and the exterior neon sign to be turned off. When we first arrived we saw one subject sitting on the stairs in front of the door. We observed multiple cars parked in front of the location as well as in the parking lot of the business. As we sat, observing the location, we observed one male arrive in a vehicle, knock on the front door, and enter the premises. A few minutes later, we observed another vehicle park in front of the business, and two people entered.

Ourselves and Squad 3312, walked up to the front door of the business and knocked. We could hear music playing in the background, and a subject yelling for people to be quiet. I observed a subject look through the blinds of the front door. A subject walked out later identified as a part owner, Wesley E HARRELL (b/m 04-01-77). HARRELL was told the instructions for businesses closing after hours. HARRELL stated he wanted to have his employees inside for a get together. HARRELL was instructed the tavern still needed to be shutdown immediately. HARRELL complied without incident.

Everyone inside the bar left the premises immediately without incident. I counted 12 people leave in about 6-7 vehicles.

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This report is being written by PO CROWDER squad 3245, while in full duty uniform equipped with Axon worn body camera operating a marked squad car. On August 28th 2019, at 12:17pm PO GAGNON and I were dispatched to a Sexual Assault at 5000 W Chambers Street located in the City/County of Milwaukee.

The caller stated there was a woman in the hospital stating she was assaulted last night at the Overtime Sport Bar and Grill between 11pm-12am. The caller also stated the victim woke up this morning on 38th and Lloyd.

Upon arrival I observed a B/F lying in a hospital bed with a blanket over her. This individual appeared to be in distress and very confused.

The individual identified herself as Doreen BRADSHAW (F/B, 9-18-83) who stated she was at a bar called "Over time sports bar and lounge" yesterday around 11pm-12am to have some drinks (long island ice tea). She stated she was carrying her luggage with her as she entered the bar. The victim also stated she was at this location the night prior to the incident.

She stated while at the bar she was accompanied by an individual which whom she knew from prior occurrences at the bar. She stated he is the bartender/bouncer of the bar. She stated while they were accompanying each other the subject asked her to go to another bar with him which she declined. The victim stated she and the subject began arguing, but does not remember what it was regarding.

She stated during the argument the subject pushed her down to the ground causing injury to her right elbow, left leg, and tailbone. She did not lose consciousness, but woke up near 38th and Lloyd and does not know how she got there but believes she walked to the location.

The victim stated several times "I know who the guy is", but when asked "What is his name" she replies "I do not know his name." She described the individual as a medium dark male, 30-40yoa, 5'11"-6'1" medium build, short hair, and big pupils.

The victim stated her luggage is missing and believes they gave it to her outside or it is still inside the location. She described her belongings as a red suitcase, and two back packs. One black/green in color and the other grey/black colored. She stated her clothes, documents and other personal property were contained inside. Lastly, she valued the clothes inside at \$5,000 due to it being "Designer clothes."

During my interview with the victim she appeared to be very confused, not answer certain

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questions when asked and made random statements regarding unrelated situations. The victim stated she is a victim of Human Trafficking and believes the subject was trying to human traffic her if she entered the "Uber" with him.

The victim stated that she was not sexually assaulted, but physically assaulted during this incident and would like to be driven back to the location where the alleged Battery occurred to identify the subject.

The victim was admitted at 11:13am and treated by PA Brent VISSAT stated she seemed "Paranoid and Delusional." The victim also refused imaging.

On September 15th2019, at 6:15pm PO WHITTENBERGER and I conducted follow up regarding a Battery, at Overtime Bar and Lounge located at 4106 W Lisbon AV in the City/County of Milwaukee.

I spoke to an employee who identified himself as Christopher L GARNER (M/B, 11-2-85) stating he was working at the bar the day of the incident and does not remember any incidents occurring while at the bar.

I also spoke with the owner of the establishment, whom identified himself as Wesley E HARRELL (M/B, 4-1-77) stating there was nothing brought to his attention regarding any incidents on the listed day.

I did not observe any cameras within the establishment. PO WHITTENBERGER informed the owner regarding there needing to be cameras in the establishment for compliance with the City of Milwaukee

This report is written by PO Devin WHITFIELD, assigned to District Three, Late Power Shift.

On Saturday, October 26, 2019 at 1:16 AM, PO Lydia RIVERA-HOLEY and I (squad 3465) responded to Overtime Sports Bar, located at 4106 W Lisbon Ave in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin for a Shooting.

Upon arrival, officers located two shooting victims: Victim 1 was shot to the head and was pulse-less/not breathing (later pronounced deceased), and Victim 2 was observed to have a graze wound to her lower back. See IR# 192990016 for reports regarding this Shooting.

Summary of Shooting

Multiple residents from the neighborhood and patrons from the bar called police regarding the Shooting. Witnesses reported multiple gunshots were fired and that there was a man laying in the middle of the street not moving.

According to patrons inside the bar and other witnesses, the homicide victim was attempting to gain entry into the bar but refused to be searched by security. The victim got into a verbal argument with security and was eventually turned away at the door. Witnesses on scene stated that the victim then walked away and retrieved a firearm from his ankle, and started firing towards the bar. A subject at the bar (unknown if he was a patron or employee) identified as Christopher GARNER (b/m, 11-02-85) and a manager at the bar, identified as Wesley E HARRELL (b/m, 04-01-77) returned fire, striking the victim in

the head and elsewhere on the body.

MPD Detectives' investigation revealed that W. HARRELL was in possession of a firearm and fired nine shots from his firearm during the Shooting. The firearm that W. HARRELL used in the Shooting was reported stolen from an unlocked vehicle on 05-29-12.

The other manager of Overtime Sports Bar, identified as Lashunda V HARRELL (b/f, 07-01-66) was on scene during the incident.

The owner, Mary M HARRELL (b/f, 08-08-47) later arrived on scene and was uncooperative with the investigation.

It should be noted that M. HARRELL is the mother of L. HARRELL and W. HARRELL, M. HARRELL initially gave MPD Detectives consent to search the bar for evidence related to the Shooting, but later rescinded consent after being unhappy with how MPD Detectives were handling the investigation.

Even with knowledge of the fact that this Shooting was related to her tavern and knowing that one or more of her employees were involved in the shooting, M. HARRELL still rescinded her consent to search the bar.

MPD Detectives had to obtain a search warrant for the bar .

This report is written by P.O. Andrew KEMPEN, assigned to District 3, Late Power Shift, Tavern Squad.

On Thursday, November 14th, 2019 at approximately 4:00 PM, a meeting was conducted at District 3 (2333 N 49th St) the licensee of Overtime Sports Bar and Lounge, Mary M HARRELL (F/B 8/8/47) and two owners of the building, Susan FLEEGE (F/W 9/25/57) and Ralph A FLEEGE (M/W 6/1/64). The meeting was schedule due to a recent shooting that occurred in front of this location as well as an after hours and battery complaint. The meeting was conducted with Captain Jeffery NORMAN - District 3 Commander, Sgt Chad RADEN - License Investigation Unit, Assistant District Attorney Kelly O'NEILL, P.O. Dorian WHITTENBERGER - CPU, P.O. Melvin FINKLEY - CPU, and myself.

HARRELL stated that she runs the bar with her children and grandchildren and is involved in the daily operation of the location. HARRELL was asked about her cooperation during the investigation of the shooting, which she clarified that she was on the way to the location when notified by a police officer and when she arrived a Detective told her that she could either allow them to search or they would get a search warrant so she requested that he get a search warrant. HARRELL stated that she was cooperative and it was the Detective that became rude and after he grabbed her son's phone out of his hand and her phone and told them to leave that the Detective said that he would have her license.

HARRELL was also asked about the security they employ which she stated that they use people that they know from the neighborhood and that her understand was the situation started when their security refused to allow someone in because he was armed and that the subject was not a patron of theirs because they had refused him at the door. HARRELL was advised that if she is going to have security they should be licensed by the state and bonded.

HARRELL advised us that she had already spoken to her children about the rules of the hours and that everyone needed to be out that wasn't cleaning and that there would not be any further issues on that.

Finally the issue of cameras was brought up to HARRELL which she stated that she was already looking into possibly getting. HARRELL was advised of possible programs that might help her obtain and setup security cameras.

HARRELL, FLEEGE and FLEEGE where advised on possible camera requirements or the possibility of nuisance property in the future and were advised as to the process which that would be handled if it came to that as well as the appeal process. They were given paper copies of the nuisance guidelines and contact information for the District personnel.

HARRELL was cooperative. She was notified that District 3 was going to continue to monitor the issues and calls for services at the location.


