Our Conference theme is "Vision 2020: Strength in Numbers." As we do every year, we recognize Latino leaders because you are the embodiment of the progress our community is making. You represent the empowerment that our community has worked hard for and won.

For 37 years USHLI has empowered Latinos and similarly disenfranchised groups by promoting education, leadership development, unity, and non-partisan civic participation. USHLI has registered over **2.3** million new voters, empowered over **1,000,000** young Latino leaders, published over **425** reports and profiles on Latino demographics, and sponsored 37 national conferences attended annually by leaders representing **40** states.

USHLI has been honored for its work by Former President Bill Clinton, the Government of Mexico, Congressional Hispanic Caucus Institute, Univision, Hispanic Heritage Foundation, Latino Leaders Network, American Immigration Forum, Latino Business Magazine, Latino Leaders Magazine, Latino Magazine, and the Association of Hispanics in Higher Education.

A survey of our 2019 participants found that **65**% were Female, **89**% were 18-34 years of age, and **82**% were attending or had completed college. The survey also found that **7**% of our attendees are pursuing an advanced degree. USHLI conference participants represent the future generations who will provide the leadership needed in every segment of an American society that will become over **25**% Hispanic during their lifetime, with a population of over 100 million in the United States.
