S. 38th Street and W. Lapham St. The neighbors and I are and I reside on My name is concerned about the businesses on the south west corner or 38th and Lapham. It has come to our attention that the owner has applied for a body shop and wholesale/second hand retail license (vehicles) on the south west corner of the property. The businesses at this corner already takes up our street parking with tow trucks constantly dropping off damaged cars on the adjacent roadways along with dumping car parts that we all constantly have to pick up or call the City about. Not to mention constant oil and fluids leaks all over the roadway. Now I've heard/read on Accela that they want to obtain a dealership and body shop license. I find this very inconsiderate and hard to believe that the City and the Aldermanic office would grant permission as these businesses are already running down the neighborhood and not up to code. We are all constantly calling the City regarding these reoccurring issues. Not only this but how can a dealership/body shop be approved for a license or occupancy permit on a gravel lot with a pull shed as an office/garage? I've walked passed and they don't even have a paint booth and they have already been fixing/painting cars at the location on the south west corner of the lot for at least the past year. In addition, the subject pull shed at the south west corner is the source of many of the oil leaks/car parts left in the right of way. I don't see how this is environmentally safe or even up to code or how they have been in business without a license prior to this. I am in the process of putting together a petition and I am also contacting DNS/City of Milwaukee to find out why/how this license would even be able to process when not up to code. Operating a business prior to proper licensing will not be welcomed or tolorated by our community. Please hear the voice of our community - Burnham Park and put a stop to this. I would appreciate if you kept my name and address anonymous as this location seems to be very shady.



- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
