The purpose of the Birthing M.O.M.S project is to provide mothers with free, lead safe kits prior to hospital discharge. These kits contain educational materials, cleaning supplies, and a water filter pitcher and 1-year supply of refills. As public health professionals we are aware that exposure to lead in utero and/or early life can contribute to delayed fetal growth, infant morbidity and/or mortality. The MHD remains committed to promoting positive birth outcomes so families can live their best lives, which aligns with the MHD vision.
