1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):  
Implementation of uniform every other week recycling collection to all 1 – 4 unit households serviced citywide. Currently, the City provides recycling collection of bins and carts at varying service level frequencies.
2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:  
Uniform recycling collection supports the goal of greater resource recovery and improved sustainability. Uniform recycling collection aims to increase recycling participation, divert greater amounts of recoverable materials from the landfill and save on waste disposal tipping fees.
3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):  
The grant agreement provides \$649,000 grant for the purchase and distribution of recycling carts and education and outreach support. The grant agreement also provides raw material to a third party cart vendor to be used in the manufacturing of recycling carts, thus lowering the procurement cost to the City for additional recycling carts. The resulting cost of additional carts purchased by the City will total \$24,758.
