A. Findings

No substantial changes to format under Finding 1. Made citations into footnotes for consistency with other work groups. Need citations for the following on page 21:

- “Closely intertwined with economic inequality, is environmental racism: the disproportionate location of environmental hazards in or near economically disadvantaged communities, including more toxic jobs, schools, and homes. This environmental and health inequality cuts along racial lines due to housing and school segregation and economic inequity. Nationally over 71% of Blacks and 50% of the Latinx community reside in areas with the most polluted air, while only 34% of whites do.”

Finding 3 (page 22-23) - Paragraphs were made, as well as a bullet point list of city equity initiatives, as discussed at the March 5th CCTFCEE meeting.

The bullet points under the rest of the Findings were combined into paragraphs. Nothing was removed or added.

Bullet points were kept under the description of challenges on page 26, except an introductory sentence was added.
