**Historic Preservation Commission** 

This July, CNN is excited to partner with the Milwaukee Turners to bring its CNN Grill - a staple at each political convention since 2004 - to iconic Turner Hall. The CNN Grill will serve as the network's broadcast and hospitality hub at the Democratic National Convention, where journalists, influencers, lawmakers and political junkies all gather to witness on-air programming in the making, while enjoying lively political conversation and some of the best food in town. To bring the CNN Grill to life in Milwaukee, we will install temporary signage, lighting and window graphics to allow convention attendees to locate the Grill at Turner Hall, while also highlighting the beautiful exterior of this historic building.

### Exterior Signage:

- Wall Signs:
  - The (2) existing Turner Hall metal signs will be removed, stored, and replaced following the event.
  - Attachment: wall signs will be mechanically fastened to the building per approved engineering. All work will be remediated to match the existing facade.
  - Locations: north, west, and south elevations
  - Dimensions & Materials: see slides 2 & 3
- Lollipop Sign:
  - o The existing Tavern sign will be removed, stored, and replaced.
  - Attachment: CNN Grill signage will be built to the same specifications as the existing sign and mechanically fastened to building per approved engineering.
  - Location: west elevation
  - o Dimensions & Materials: see slide 4

### **Exterior Graphics:**

- To control the amount of light in the broadcast room, the CNN Special Events (SpEv) team needs to install window graphics.
- Locations:
  - west facade: first floor windows and main entrance
  - o north elevation: first floor concrete window wells
- Dimensions & Material: perforated window vinyl cut to size of the existing windows, see slides 5 & 6

## **Exterior Lighting:**

- Main Entrance Lighting:
  - Attachment: mechanically fastened to the building per approved engineering
  - Location: west elevation main archway
  - Material: programmable RGB LED tape or LED marquee bulb lighting
- Facade Up-lighting:
  - Placement: ground
  - Locations: north and west elevation
  - Material: programmable lights with wooden surround, see slide 7
